Dear Max:

I am writing at the request of the Governor and other officials of the State of Maine who are interested in presenting the first Atlantic salmon to be caught this season to President Reagan. The season officially opens on May 1st, and they would like to make the presentation shortly thereafter.

It is my understanding that this presentation was a tradition that was observed through the Eisenhower Administration. Due to the pollution of the state's waters, this practice was discontinued. They now feel, however, that the pollution is under control and would like to once again observe this tradition.

Basically what they would like to do is arrange a brief meeting between the President, the individual who catches the first Atlantic salmon, and a representative of the State of Maine.

I understand in making this request that a meeting with the President may not be possible. If he is unable to participate, perhaps Vice President Bush would be able to do so in his behalf.

Any assistance you can offer in this matter would be greatly appreciated. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Jane Russell of my staff.


