



DEAR MR PRESIDENT

IN THE NAME OF THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC OPPOSITION (UNIDO) UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF MRS CORAZON AGUINO WITH DOCTOR SALVATORE LAUREL AND ALL FREEDOM-LOVING FILIPINOS, I WOULD LIKE TO REQUEST YOUR GOOD OFFICE TO GIVE PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THE CURRENT PRESIDENTIAL VOTE COUNT IN THE PHILIPPINES. THE TREND, IN SPITE OF REPORTS OF FRAUD AND TERRORISM, INDICATES REASONABLE EXPECTATIONS OF VICTORY FOR THE DEMOCRATIC OPPOSITION.

AMONG MANY FILIPINOS AND FILIPINO-AMERICANS, AND ESPECIALLY WITHIN THE DEMOCRATIC OPPOSITION, THERE IS A WELL FOUNDED CONCERN THAT THE BALLOT TALLY MAY BE CAST ASIDE. SUCH AN ACT COULD PROVOKE CIVIL STRIFE HITH ITS DESTABILIZING LONG-TERM CONSEQUENCES IN THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN REGION. I WOULD LIKE TO ASK YOU MOST RESPECTFULLY TO CONSIDER HAVING YOUR GOVERNMENT INTERCEDE WITH THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO CONTINUE THE TALLY OF THE VOTES, TO SAFEGUARD THE INTEGRITY OF MAMFREL INATIONAL MOVEMENT FOR FREE ELECTIONS IN THE DISCHARGE OF ITS FUNCTION TO MAKE AN INDEPENDENT COUNT OF THE VOTES.

HORE SPECIFICALLY, PRESIDENT MARCOS CAN BE ASKED TO CONSTITUTE A BI-PARYISAN NATIONAL COUNCIL TO BE COMPOSED OF MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE PARLIAMENT AND REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE MOSLEM COMMUNITY, THE LEADERSHIP OF CHRISTIAN CHURCHES AND THE BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS. Such a COUNCIL CAN ACT TO STUDY AND ANTICIPATE THE PROBLEMS OF AN ORDERLY AND PEACEFUL TRANSITION OF AUTHORITY THROUGH NEW GOVERNMENT.

THE CREANIZATION OF THAT COUNCIL WOULD ALLAY THE FEARS AND ANXIETY OF A PEOPLE DEEPLY CONCERNED THAT ITS SOVEREIGN WILL MIGHT BE FRUSTRATED.

DUFING THIS CRITICAL MOMENT IN THE PHILIPPINES THE COUNCIL WILL BE AN EFFECTIVE VEHICLE TO AVERT THE HARSH POLARIZATION OF PHILIPPINE SOCIETY AND ITS PLUNGE TOWARDS POLITICAL DISCORD THAT COULD THREATEN THE PEACE IN THE ASIAN PACIFIC REGION.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR ATTENTION AND WE WOULD APPRECIATE YOUR RESPONSE TO THIS REQUEST. 
