



- Gen. B: Say, the Governor of Georgia said that he is vary much in earnest about trying to get this WAC recruiting going, you know, and he's got a show coming up from Cochran Field and he tried to send a telegram yesterday, I think tried to get you people to send Clark Gable down here. You turned him down on that, so now they want to try to get another of your movie stars and I told him I'd put in a call and see if I could help on it. I suppose you get plenty of calls like that
- Gen. G: Oh, yes. We have calls continuously for some of these celebrities and wherever possible we send them down unless it violates some policy of General Marshall.
- Gen. B: Yes, well this fan they'd like to get now is a fellow I never heard of a First Lieutenant Ronald Reagan, and he's got a movie actor for a wife called Jane Wyman. I think they'll fix it up so she'll come if he can come. That'll be two of them.
- Gen. G: What time did you want them down there?
- Gen. B: What's that?
- Gen. G: What time and where did you want them?
- Gen. B: Well, let's see. They wanted them on the 18th they've got this air show coming up from Cochran Field which they're going to have at the auditorium or somewhere. They're going to have these people at the same time. It's all in the interest of getting these Air WAC's going.
- Gen. G: I will pass this information on and see what we can do about sending him down there on the 18th.
- Gen. B: That will be fine.
- Gen. G: Will it be a day show or a night show?
- Gen. B: The Governor is interested and I'd like to keep him interested.
- Gen. G: All right. And we, I know, in the Air Forces are doing what we can now to help out on this WAC recruiting.
- Gen. B: Yes.


