SUBJECT: Appointment Request: Foreign Minister Genscher
Hans-Dietrich

Genscher just asked, via the German Embassy, to meet with you while in Washington next week. He hopes to see you either immediately following his brief session with the President (Wednesday, April 16 at 9:45 a.m.), or immediately following a meeting he has arranged with Don Regan at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 15.

The German Embassy has not identified topics, but they seem obvious: East-West relations, terrorism, and the Tokyo Summit. Our guys would also want you to put down a marker on SDI -- Genscher was the chief German skeptic about SDI participation.

While we do not like Don Regan meeting with Foreign Ministers, given fact that such a meeting is set, it might make more sense for you and Don to meet together with Genscher.


