SUBJECT: Energy Contingency Planning (S)

I want to take this opportunity to express my appreciation for a job well done. In my opinion, the work on international energy contingency planning has gone extremely well, thanks in large part to the efforts of the Department of Energy and especially Don Pearlman. (S)

As you are probably aware, we will be continuing consultations with our allies over the next several weeks on the current stock situation and the question of stock coordination during a crisis. The success of these efforts will, in part, depend on the credibility of our domestic contingency planning. I am somewhat concerned that work on domestic energy and economic policy issues has not moved as swiftly as the work on our international energy policy. As a result, we have not been able to compile the common briefing book promised to the Cabinet at the 20 March NSC meeting on Iran-Iraq energy issues. I urge you and your staff to move forward to conclude work on these issues with all due speed so our policy options can be clearly defined and the briefing book can be completed and submitted to the President by early May. (S)

SUBJECT: Update on Iran-Iraq Energy Working Groups

Summary. Implementation of international energy policy, per the guidelines established in NSDD-134, is proceeding on schedule. Special emphasis is being placed on the consultative process and developing an adequate public information strategy.

International Energy Policy. As I reported earlier, initial consultations have already been held within the IEA. There was widespread enthusiasm for our suggestions and, as a result, follow-up work is underway to establish an IEA mechanism for consultations on the stock situation among major countries with a view toward developing a common approach to stock coordination during a crisis. I have also had quiet discussions with Ulf Lantzke and Acting Director Hopkins about proceeding on a fast track in order to ensure adequate preparation which will parallel preparations for the Summit. Both have assured me that they will meet this schedule. *good* ✓

The first formal round of bilateral consultations is scheduled to begin next week. Undersecretary Wallis will be leading a delegation to London, Bonn, Paris and Rome. As I will be on leave, I strongly recommend that Roger Robinson accompany Wallis. During the first week in May, Ambassador Fairbanks will be returning to the Far East to follow-up on earlier discussions in Japan. A strategy paper for use in these discussions is being prepared.

In addition to the above consultations, the IEA is scheduling a low profile May meeting outside Paris to discuss the stock situation and coordination among the major consuming countries. This will be a vital step in obtaining consensus among the allies.

Public Information. State and DOE are currently drafting, per NSDD-134, a comprehensive public information strategy covering what we can do to educate key opinion leaders prior to a crisis and how to best respond after a disruption in order to disseminate accurate information to calm the market. Once this plan of action is completed it will be forwarded to the NSC for approval. Should the war in the Persian Gulf heat up again, we may want to offer a background briefing to the Democratic Presidential candidates to reduce sniping (hopefully) in this sensitive area.

Other Areas. Very slow progress is being in the other areas under review within the interagency process. Until work is finished on domestic energy and economic policy options, it will not be possible to complete the planned common briefing book for the Cabinet. DOE and Treasury are still working on analysis and position papers on issues in these areas. It would be useful to give this work a little prodding by sending the attached memo to Secretary Hodel in his role as chairman of the Energy Response Working Group.

SUBJECT: IEA Discussions on Emergency Preparedness

Issue

Background on follow-up consultations concerning international energy policy within the International Energy Agency (IEA).

Facts

The U.S. delegation to last week's IEA Governing Board made a very successful presentation on U.S. international energy policy based on the guidelines you established during the NSC meeting on energy implications of the Iran-Iraq war, as embodied in NSDD-134.

Discussion

Our representative highlighted the need for appropriate international policies, including:

- o Coordinated stock policies.
- o The need for increased strategic stocks.
- o An effective public information strategy to calm the market.
- o Other means to reduce demand on the world oil market in a disruption.

We noted the importance of fairly sharing the burden of a disruption among the allies with each country responding through measures appropriate to its own situation. The other members of the IEA were very receptive of our views and were particularly appreciative of our clarification of U.S. international energy policy. As a result, the IEA agreed to activate extensive work on stock coordination in a crisis.

In sum, I believe we are off to an excellent start in the international arena thanks to sound policy formation and good execution by our representatives abroad.
