2. TBS-TV REPORTED FROM LONDON THAT A BRITISH TELEVISION STATION ANNOUNCED THE CONTENTS OF HAIG'S FIVE-POINT MEDIATION PLAN WHICH, THE STATION SAID, CALLED FOR SHELIVING THE SOVEREIGNTY PROBLEM FOR FIVE YEARS.

3. AMONG THE NEWSPAPERS, THE LEADING MONDAY MORNING TOKYO DAILIES GAVE PAGE-ONE AND INSIDE-PAGE PLAY TO REPORTS ON THE HAIG MISSION.

4. THE ASAHI PUBLISHED A FRONT-PAGE REPORT. ITS BUENOS AIRES CORRESPONDENT KIKUCHI SAID HAIG IS BELIEVED TO HAVE PRESENTED A FIVE-POINT MEDIATION PLAN WHICH CALLS ON THE TWO SIDES TO DEFER THE SOVEREIGNTY PROBLEM FOR FIVE YEARS. THE REPORT SAID THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S MEDIATION EFFORTS WERE TAKING CONSIDERABLE TIME BECAUSE OF AN APPARENT DIFFERENCE OF VIEWS WITHIN THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT ON ACCEPTANCE OF THE PLAN. THE ASAHI SAID, "THE SITUATION IS VERY FLUID AMID REPORTS THAT HAIG WILL LEAVE BUENOS AIRES ON APRIL 18."

5. AMONG THE INSIDE-PAGE REPORTS, THE YOMIURI'S SHIMANAKA REPORTED ON THE EXTENSION OF SECRETARY HAIG'S STAY IN ARGENTINA AND SAID IT WAS BECAUSE THE ARGENTINE SIDE REFUSED TO MAKE CONCESSIONS ON THE TERRITORIAL PROBLEM. THE REPORT SAID THERE IS A PESSIMISTIC VIEW IN SOME SECTIONS OF BUENOS AIRES ABOUT THE FUTURE OF THE FIVE-POINT PROPOSAL.

6. THE MAINICHI'S BUENOS AIRES CORRESPONDENT TAKIMOTO SAID SECRETARY HAIG EXPERIENCED DIFFICULTIES IN HIS MEDIATION EFFORTS BECAUSE OF THE STRONG STAND OF THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT ON THE SOVEREIGNTY PROBLEM.

7. AMONG THE EDITORIALS, THE SANKEI COMMENTED SATURDAY THAT "WE SINCERELY HOPE A WAY WILL BE FOUND TO RESOLVE THE DISPUTE QUICKLY BEFORE IT DEVELOPS INTO A MAJOR CRISIS." THE SANKEI SAID, "IF THE BRITISH FLEET TRIES TO RETAKE THE FALKLANDS, IT IS CERTAIN THAT THERE WILL BE MORE VICTIMS AMONG THE 1,800 RESIDENTS OF BRITISH STOCK IN THE ISLANDS THAN THOSE RESCUED."
