O. MEXICAN PERMREP SAID THAT WHATEVER THE PARTIES! DIFFERENCES, THE NEW ESCALATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM VIOLATED 502 AND THE CHARTER, AS WELL AS WRECKED THE SECGEN'S NEGOTIATIONS. SELF DEFENSE UNDER ARTICLE 51 PRESUPPOSES THAT THE SOVEREIGNTY QUESTION HAS BEEN SETTLED. THE SECURITY COUNCIL ALONE CAN MAINTAIN AND RESTURE INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY SINCE THE NATURE OF THE MODERN INTERNATIONAL ORDERISCOLLECTIVE SECURITY AND THE INDIVIDUAL USE OF FORCE IS ILLEGITIMATE. MEXICO SUPPORTS ARGENTINA'S CLAIM BUT REJECTS THE USE UF FORCE TO SOLVE DISPUTES. ARGENTINA AND THE UK YESTERDAY STATED THEIR WILLINGNESS TO CONTINUE NEGOTIATING AND THE COUNCIL SHOULD GET THEM TO DO SO IN

URDER TO IMPLEMENT 502 SINCE NO MILITARY VICTORY COULD LEGITIMATE A TERRITORIAL CLAIM.

7. CURAN PERMREP SAID THAT THE INVASION OF THE MALVINAS BY THE UK HAS "THE UNMASKED SUPPORT" OF THE US. UK MILITARY ACTION IS A VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW, THE CHARTER AND 502 AND CONSTITUTES GUN-BOAT DIPLOMACY. THE US "PLUT" REFLECTED IN THE RIO TREATY SYSTEM HAS BEEN DESTROYED IN THIS HOUR OF LATIN AMERICAN SOLIDARITY AGAINST THE COLONIAL WAR. THE SECGEN'S NEGOTIATIONS WERE "INTERRUPTED BY THE UK." EC SANCTIONS ARE NOT IN LINE WITH THE CHARTER.

8. BULIVIAN PERMPREP SUPPORTED ARGENTINA'S CLAIM TO THE MALVINAS BUT ALSO EMPHASIZED NUM-USF OF FORCE. HE

HE CALLED THIS A CASE OF "DISPROPORTIONATE FURCE" BY A MAJOR POWER AGAINST A THIRD WURLD COUNTRY; A RE-ENACTMENT OF COLONIALISM. HE SAID THAT THE FIRST AGGRESSION HAD BEEN COMMITTED BY THE UK IN 1833 AND THAT THEREFORE LEGITIMATE SELF DEFENSE WAS BEING EXERCISED BY ARGENTINA. 9. PANAMANIAN FORMIN ILLUECA EMPHASIZED LATIN AMERICAN SOLIDARITY AND INVOKED THE LIBERATORS BOLIVAR AND SAN MARTIN. HE CALLED THE FALKLANDS DISPUTE A CASE OF TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY IN THE FACE OF COLONIALISM. HE LABELED THE UK INTRANSIGENT AND "ANTI HISTORICAL" SAYING THAT HMG WAS ENGAGING IN PUNATIVE EXPEDITIONS TO HUMILLIATE ARGENTINA, FORGETTING THAT ALL OF LATIN AMERICA OPPOSES THEM. HE SAID THAT SELF DEFENSE DOES NOT APPLY IN THIS SITUATION. THE FALKLANDS HAS LED TO A CRISIS IN THE LATIN AMERICAN SYSTEM IN GENERAL AND THE RID TREATY IN PARTICULAR. THE UK HAD ITSELF VIOLATED 502. ILLUECA REASONED THAT WHEN 502 WAS PASSED AND CALLED FOR CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES, THERE WERE NO HOSTILITIES. SUBSEQUENTLY THE UK HAD ACTED WITH MILITARY FORCE AND THEREBY BECOME THE AGGRESSUR. HE INVOKED THE UN RESULUTIONS ON THE FALKLANDS. IN CONCLUDING ILLUECA UPINED THAT WHAT NEEDEDTUBENEGOTIATED IN THE FALKLANDS CRISIS WAS THE WITHDRAWAL OF BRITISH FORCES, AND THAT THE REST WAS A COLONIAL QUESTION WHICH COULD BE HANDLED BY THE UNITED NATIONS. 10. CANADIAM AMBASSADOR PELLETIER SAID THAT HE WAS SPEAKING TO THE COUNCIL DUE THE FAILURE OF ONE PARTY TO THE DISPUTE TO ADHERE TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL DECISION IN 502. HE SAID THAT THE RESORT TO FORCE IN A DISPUTE, THE SEIZURE OF A COMMUNITY AND THE IMPOSITION ON IT OF A REGIME WHICH IT CONSIDERED FOREIGN HAD SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES FOR THE HULE OF LAW, LEADING TO "LAW OF THE JUNGLE AND THE DIMMING OF VALUES WE HOLD DEAR IN CIVILIZATION." ARGENTINA INITIATED THE HOSTILITIES AND CANADA HAD BEEN FORCED TO IMPOSE SANCTIONS. A MEGOTIATED SOLUTION IS THE DNLY CIVILIZED COURSE OF ACTION. CANADA MAKES NO JUDGMENT ON THE TERRITORIAL CLAIMS AS LONG AS DUE REGARD IS PAID TO THE WISHES OF THE ISLANDERS THEMSELVES. INDEED CAMADA STOOD READY TO FACILITATE NEGOTIATIONS UR ASSIST IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A SETTLEMENT IF REQUESTED. 11. GUATEMALAN DELEGATION SUPPORTED ARGENTINA'S RIGHTS

IN AN EXTENDED ANALYSIS OF THE DOCTRINE OF SELF DEFENSE, PARSONS SAID THAT CAUSE OF THE FALKLANDS CRISIS IS AN ARGENTINE INVASION AND SUBSEQUENT REFUSAL TO OBEY THE CALL OF 502 FOR UNCONDITIONAL WITHDRAWAL. BY KEMOVING THIS CAUSE ONE WOULD ALSO HALT ITS EFFECT -- THE HOSTILITIES. IN REPLY TO ARGENTINE DEPUTY FUREIGN MINISTER RUSS, PARSONS REMINDED THE COUNCIL THAT THE UK HAS NOT CLAIMED THAT 502 GIVES IT ANY RIGHT. RATHER ARTICLE 51 OF THE CHARTER SAYS THAT NOTHING IN THE CHARTER SHALL IMPAIR IN THE INHERENT RIGHT OF SELF DEFENSE. PARSONS CITED ROSS TO THE EFFECT THAT UNCE THE COUNCIL HAS ACTED, SELF DEFENSE IS NO LONGER PROPER AND SAID THAT THIS DUCTRINE WOULD LEAD TO ABSURD RESULTS. 13. ROSS , SPEAKING IN RIGHT UF REPLY SAID THAT 502 DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE UK TO BE A GENDARME. THE GOA HAD SAID THAT IT WOULD COMPLY WITH 502 WHOLLY. ARGENTINA WOULD NOT COMPLY ON A PARAGRAPH BY PARAGRAPH BASIS WITH TIMING DETERMINED BY THE UK. ROSS CALLED THE FALKLANDS A COLUNIAL SETTLEMENT OF 800 FAMILIES AND SAID THAT THIS LED TO EXAGGERATION OF PRINCIPLE. ROSSAID THAT
