Sheikh Sa'ad, Crown Prince and Prime Minister of Kuwait, has accepted President Reagan's invitation for an Official Working Visit to Washington, including a July 12 meeting and lunch with the President.

Sheikh Sa'ad is an active prime minister and key decisionmaker in the Kuwaiti government. He has played a central role in the recent dramatic improvement in U.S.-Kuwaiti relations resulting, in part, from increased cooperation in the maritime protection effort. His visit, the first by a Kuwaiti leader in twenty years, is of major importance in light of the strengthened bilateral relationship, continuing efforts to coordinate Gulf War diplomacy, Kuwait's leadership of the Islamic Conference, and Kuwait's active role in the Arab world.

During his visit, Sheikh Sa'ad will meet with senior Administration officials. We are working to schedule meetings with the Secretaries of State, Defense, Energy, and Treasury, as well as with Congressional leaders.

Sheikh Sa'ad has recently hosted a number of senior Administration, Congressional, and military visitors, including Secretary Carlucci last January. The Department believes it would be valuable for the Vice President to host a function for Prime Minister/Crown Prince Sheikh Sa'ad during his visit to reciprocate for Kuwait's warm hospitality to American visitors and to hear first hand Kuwait's views of the evolving situation in the Gulf.


