#### 1. WHERE DOES THE RELATIONSHIP STAND?

- O U.S.-Kuwaiti cooperation in the escort operation has strengthened the bilateral relationship.
- o Kuwait provides important political, logistical, and financial support to our forces in the Gulf.
- o Kuwait's request for F-18 aircraft is a political act signifying Kuwait's desire for a long-term military supply relationship with the U.S. and its willingness to share the burden for its own and Gulf defense.
- o Both countries support efforts in the UN to bring Iran to the negotiating table.
- We share a concern for the need to combat terrorism and a policy of no negotiations with or concessions to terrorists.
