Swiss Deputy FM, Edouard Brunner, will be in Washington October 2-7 and has requested a meeting with Admiral Poindexter. Brunner is a staunch friend of the United States and a valued interlocutor on European security issues (especially CDE and CSCE). Although he is the deputy FM, in fact he functions more as the Minister (FM Aubert's position is more ceremonial).

Brunner met with Bud last year but that was primarily because the meeting fell a month before the Reagan-Gorbachev Summit in Geneva. We do not recommend that JMP see him this time, but do feel it would be very useful for you to chair a session in the Situation Room on European security issues with Brunner. Bill Cockell and Sven Kraemer would attend, and Jack Matlock would meet with him later to discuss East-West issues.
