Attached at Tab I is a Schedule Proposal from Paul Stevens to Fred Ryan recommending a five-minute photo op for the Vice President of Switzerland, Jean-Pascal Delamuraz, who will serve as the Swiss President next year. The President recently saw Elizabeth Kopp, the current attorney-general and President-designate after Delamuraz, for a similar five-minute appointment at the urging of Attorney General Meese.

The President's schedule is tight at that time, but frankly, the Swiss do a lot for us and don't ask for much. As you know they serve as our protecting power in Iran and Cuba and have been instrumental in arranging key East-West Summits and other conclaves. More to the point, the Swiss are expected to announce this week that they have narrowed the competition for their follow-on fighter to two planes -- both American -- the F-16 and F-18. Delamuraz, a former defense minister, undoubtedly played a key role in that decision.

SUBJECT: Presidential Appointment with Swiss Vice President Delamuraz

The Vice President of Switzerland, Jean-Pascal Delamuraz, will visit Washington February 8 through 10. He is concurrently the Federal Councilor (Cabinet Minister) for Public Economy: his duties in that position are equivalent to those of Commerce, Labor, Agriculture, and USTR. He is a former Defense Minister, a member of the center-right Liberal Democratic Party, and the strongest electoral figure in the Swiss coalition government. Under the system of rotating leadership, he will become President of Switzerland in January 1989.

The Swiss Embassy has asked on Delamuraz' behalf for a brief meeting with President Reagan. This request is strongly seconded by Ambassador Whittlesey in Bern. The President met briefly (about five minutes) with the Swiss Justice Minister, Elisabeth Kopp, when she visited in November.
