Subject: Meeting between President Reagan and President Bourguiba of Tunisia

Habib Bourguiba, President of Tunisia since its independence in 1956, will arrive in the United States on January 16 for medical treatment in Washington (Walter Reed Hospital) and Philadelphia. We recommend that the President invite him to the White House for a 30-minute meeting on January 21 or 22.

A meeting between President Reagan and President Bourguiba would be an important way to show our support for the moderate policies of Tunisia under President Bourguiba, who is seeking to bind his country's destiny to that of the United States before he passes from the scene. Having warded off a Libyan-backed raid in 1980, Tunisia continues to face the threat of subversion and even attack from neighboring Libya. The Tunisians feel that one of the best ways to deter Qadhafi's adventurism is to demonstrate strong ties to the U.S. Bourguiba cherishes his personal relationship with Presidents as far back as Eisenhower, and a meeting would encourage him to continue to be helpful to us not only against the Soviets and Qadhafi, but also against the radical forces in the Arab world seeking to disrupt the peace process in the Middle East.

The President's wife, Wassila Bourguiba, will accompany the President. She plays a significant role in the political life of the country, and we therefore hope that Mrs. Reagan could host a brief tea for Mrs. Bourquiba.
