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#### PETER SEBASTIAN

Peter Sebastian, born 1926, served in the U.S. Army in World War II (Philippines, Japan). He attended Roosevelt College and the University of Chicago and did course work at the New School for Social Research in New York as well as the Universite d'Aix Marseille. Before joining the U.S. Foreign Service, he was owner-director of a language consulting business in New York (1951-1957).

Peter Sebastian began his foreign service as consular, then political officer in Rabat, Morocco (1957-1960). He was transferred to the Department as research officer in 1960, assigned to Bangui, Central African Republic, as political/ economic officer in 1961 before moving to Paris as political officer (1963-1967). Following his Paris tour, Sebastian returned to the Department as desk officer for Mauritania, Senegal and The Gambia, then for Algeria (1967-1969). He attended the National War College (1969-1970) and, thereafter, worked on policy issues in the Department's Bureau of Politico-Military Affairs (1971-1972). In 1972 Sebastian was assigned to the American Embassy, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia as Political Counselor. In 1976 he returned to Washington to become Deputy Executive Secretary of the Department. Detached the following year, he attended the Executive Seminar in National and International Affairs. In 1978 he was assigned as the American Consul General to Casablanca, Morocco and was transferred to the position of Deputy Chief of Mission/Charge d'Affaires a.i. Embassy Rabat in 1980, remaining to 1982. He then returned to Washington to serve as Country Director for North Africa in the Department.

Mr. Sebastian is married to the former Harvel E. Huddleston, a development anthropologist. They have a grown son, Christopher, and reside in Bethesda, Maryland. Mrs. Sebastian has worked extensively in Black and North Africa-designing water and health development projects especially in the Sahel.
