SUBJECT: Appointment Request: Italian Prime Minister Fanfani

Amintore Fanfani, Prime Minister of Italy, has requested a meeting with the President Wednesday, May 27 as part of his pre-Summit consultations. He will already have visited Paris, Bonn, London, Tokyo, and possibly also Ottawa before coming to Washington. He plans to see the Secretary as well as Secretary Baker.

Fanfani, a respected Italian politician and five times Prime Minister, will chair the Economic Summit this June. He will head the government until the June 14 elections and the formation of a new government.

We have important objectives at the Venice Summit concerning agriculture, international monetary and trade policy, East-West relations and arms control, terrorism, and South Africa. We do not yet have agreement to all of our major initiatives. Fanfani wants to take a leadership role at the Summit and we believe he will be responsive to our goals. The Department of State strongly endorses this request for an appointment with the President in the interest of a successful Summit. We would also recommend hosting a lunch in his honor, if this could be arranged, as an important gesture to a longstanding ally who is working to ensure a successful President visit and Summit.


TALIAN MINISTER OF DEFENSE VALERIO ZANONE

- -- Welcome to Washington. Always good to see such a great friend of the United States.
- -- Cap has told me of the tremendous efforts you have made in Italy to garner support for our policies in the Persian Gulf.
- -- We are very pleased with the Italian decision to send the naval contingent to the Gulf. Know this was a difficult decision and that it happened largely due to your personal involvement.
- -- We hope that Allied ships will remain in the Gulf until such time as Iran begins to act responsibly. At same time, we need to push ahead urgently on implementation of UNSC resolution 598.
- -- Alliance solidarity has been an important factor strengthening the US negotiating position with the Soviet Union, and it will be important in the Senate ratification process as well. We believe an INF agreement will be reached soon. Carrying through with NATO programs to improve our conventional defense capabilities will become all the more important.
- -- Again, we deeply appreciate your support. Please tell Prime
  Minister Goria that I look forward to seeing him in
  December.

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
