BEGIN TEXT: I HOPE, AMONG OTHERS, YOU HAVE SEEN THE REUTERS PIECE BY JEFFREY ANTEVIL, DATELINE AMMAN, JORDAN, FEBRUARY 13. THIS PIECE SAYS IT ALL! IT WOULD BE HARD TO OVERSTATE WHAT HAS HAPPENED THIS WEEK WITH RESPECT TO OUR MIDDLE EAST POLICY AND MY EFFORTS OVER THE LAST MONTHS. ALL NEWSMEN ON MY PLANE HAVE SOUGHT TO FURTHER GENERATE JUSTIFIED CONTROVERSY ABOUT CAPIS INTRUSIONS INTO FUNDAMENTAL FOREIGN POLICY AREAS. I HAVE NOT AND WILL NOT JOIN THE DEBATE. BUT YOU MUST KNOW THAT THIS MATTER NEEDS IMMEDIATE ATTENTION FROM THE PRESIDENT. GLAD YOU ARE HAVING AS MUCH FUN AS I HAVE HAD BUT SINCERELY HOPE YOU HAVE MORE STAMINA. WARM REGARDS. AL. END OF TEXT.

AN-WEINBERGER-POLICY (NEWS ANALYSIS) (5 TAKES)

BY JEFFREY ANTEUIL

ANNAN, JORDAN, FEB 13, REUTER -- CASPAR WEINBERGER HAS MADE IT CLEARER THAN EVER IN RECENT DAYS THAT HE WILL GO RIGHT ON VIOLATING THE TABOO AGAINST DEFENSE SECRETARIES MAKING U.S. FOREIGN POLICY.

THROUGHOUT A NINE-DAY, THREE-NATION MIDDLE EAST TRIP OSTENSIBLY DEVOTED TO U.S. ARMS SALES AND OTHER MILITARY MATTERS, MR WEINBERGER LAID OUT A POLICY COMBINING TOUGHNESS TOWARD ISRAEL WITH GESTURES TOWARD MODERATE ARAB GOVERNMENTS INTENDED TO STRENGTHEN THEIR FRIENDSHIP WITH WASHINGTON.

AT THE SAME TIME, HE MADE PUBLIC HIS FIRST MILITARY POSTURE STATEMENT AS PENTAGON CHIEF, TAKING A HARD LINE TOWARD THE SOVIET UNION, WARNING AGAINST "COSMETIC" ARMS CONTROL AGREEMENTS, AND CALLING FOR A DRASTIC REDUCTION IN EXPORTS OF WESTERN CREDITS AND TECHNOLOGY TO COMMUNIST COUNTRIES.

BOTH OF THESE DEVELOPMENTS SEEMED CERTAIN TO INCREASE TENSIONS BETWEEN MR WEINBERGER AND SECRETARY OF STATE ALEXANDER HAIG, WHO GENERALLY ADOPTS A MORE MODERATE PUBLIC STANCE AND WHO, MOREOVER, CONSIDERS HIMSELF THE PRINCIPAL FORMULATOR AND SPOKESMAN FOR ADMINISTRATION FOREIGN POLICY.

MR WEINBERGER WAS FLYING HOME TODAY, WITH A BRIEF STOPOVER FOR A SPEECH AT A DEFENSE CONFERENCE IN MUNICH.

HIS COMMENTS ON MIDDLE EAST POLICY AS HE TRAVELED FROM SAUDI ARABIA TO OMAN AND JORDAN WERE ALREADY DRAWING ANGRY REACTIONS FROM ISRAEL AND ITS SUPPORTERS IN CONGRESS.

IN SAUDI ARABIA, WHERE HE ANNOUNCED FORMATION OF A NEW JOINT MILITARY COMMITTEE, HE SAID HE HAD TOLD SAUDI OFFICIALS OF "THE VITAL NECESSITY OF HAVING THE UNITED STATES HAVE WARM, FRIENDLY RELATIONSHIPS WITH SEVERAL COUNTRIES IN THE MIDDLE EAST AND NOT CONFINE OUR FRIENDSHIP TO ONE COUNTRY."

IF THAT WASN'T CLEAR ENOUGH FOR THE ISRAELIS, A SENIOR OFFICIAL ABOARD MR WEINBERGER'S PLANE WHO ASKED NOT TO BE IDENTIFIED SAID WASHINGTON NEEDED "MANY FRIENDS" IN THE MIDDLE EAST, INCLUDING SAUDI ARABIA, OMAN AND JORDAN AS WELL AS ISRAEL.

ASKED ABOUT LIKELY ISRAELI OBJECTIONS TO THE NEW MILITARY TIES WITH THE SAUDIS, THE OFFICIAL, WHO IS PRIVY TO MR WEINBERGER'S THINKING, REPLIED: "WE SIMPLY HAVE TO BALANCE OUR INTERESTS THROUGHOUT THE MIDDLE EAST."

HE SAID RECENT ADMINISTRATION ACTIONS SUCH AS VOTING AGAINST ISRAEL AT THE UNITED NATIONS AND SUSPENDING A NEW SECURITY COOPERATION ACCORD IN RETALIATION FOR ISRAELI ANNEXATION OF THE SYRIAN GOLAN HEIGHTS "INDICATE A CHANGE OF POLICY... THAT SHOULD BE CLEAR."

NUCLEAR POWER REACTOR IN IRAQ LAST SUMMER. HE SAID SUCH
"UNILATERAL ACTS BY ANYONE ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE."

THE OFFICIAL IMPLIED THAT ISRAEL MIGHT BE RESTRAINED FROM
ACTING AGAINST ITS ARAB NEIGHBORS IF IT KNEW THE UNITED STATES
HAD CLOSE RELATIONS WITH SOME OF THEM.

HE ALSO TOLD REPORTERS THE ADMINISTRATION WAS WILLING TO
ASK CONGRESS TO LIFT A BAN ON SELLING MOBILE AIR DEFENSE
MISSILES TO JORDAN AND WOULD GIVE SERIOUS CONSIDERATION TO A
REQUEST FOR ADVANCED F-16 JET FIGHTERS IF KING HUSSEIN WANTED
THESE WEAPONS.

IT WAS FAR FROM CLEAR HOW FAR THE MODERATE ARAB STATES WERE
WILLING TO GO ALONG WITH WASHINGTON. THE AGREEMENT WITH SAUDI
ARABIA REQUIRED TOUGH BARGAINING AND SAUDI DEFENSE MINISTER
PRINCE SULTAN SAID NOTHING TO REPORTERS TO INDICATE HIS SUPPORT
FOR THE JOINT MILITARY COMMITTEE. INSTEAD, HE STRESSED THAT
U.S.-SAUDI COOPERATION WAS BASED NOT ON "MILITARY ENDEAVORS"
BUT ON ECONOMIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL EXCHANGES.

U.S. OFFICIALS CONCEDED PRIVATELY WHAT THE SAUDIS HAVE BEEN
SAYING OPENLY: RIYADH CONSIDERS THAT ISRAEL, NOT THE SOVIET
UNION OR ITS MIDDLE EAST ALLIES SUCH AS SOUTH YEMEN, IS THE KEY
THREAT.

SEVERAL SAUDI MILITARY MEN TOLD AMERICAN REPORTERS THEY
BELIEVED THE UNITED STATES WAS MORE LIKELY THAN THE SOVIET
UNION TO TRY TO SEIZE PERSIAN GULF OIL FIELDS SOME DAY.

MR WEINBERGER SEEMED TO BE INDIRECTLY REBUKING THE SAUDIS
AND OTHER ARABS WHEN HE SAID IN OMAN THAT THE ADMINISTRATION
WAS "PARTICULARLY APPRECIATIVE OF THE REALISM WITH WHICH OMAN
FACES THE THREATS AROUND HER."

HE SAID OMAN, THE ONLY PERSIAN GULF STATE TO LET U.S.
FORCES USE ITS AIR AND NAVAL BASES IN AN EMERGENCY, WAS
"WILLING TO FACE THE FACTS AND WORK WITH THE UNITED STATES TO
PRESERVE FREEDOM."

IN HIS POSTURE STATEMENT, MR WEINBERGER LAID OUT A
STRATEGIC DOCTRINE THAT INCLUDES SUSTAINED ECONOMIC WARFARE
AGAINST MOSCOW AND THREATS TO RESPOND TO SOVIET MILITARY MOVES
ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD BY SEEKING TO END SOVIET DOMINATION IN
EASTERN EUROPE.

HE CHARGED THAT WESTERN TRADE IN TECHNOLOGY WITH POTENTIAL
MILITARY APPLICATIONS AIDED THE SOVIET MILITARY MACHINE
DIRECTLY, WHILE OTHER TRADE AND COMMERCIAL CREDITS HELPED
MAINTAIN THE COMMUNIST PARTY'S HOLD OVER THE SOVIET PEOPLE.

MR WEINBERGER SOMETIMES CONFESSES JOKINGLY TO THE OFFENSE
OF "COMMITTING FOREIGN POLICY."

IN THE LAST 10 DAYS, HE HAS DONE SO TO A PERHAPS
UNPRECEDENTED DEGREE. BUT IT REMAINS TO BE SEEN WHETHER HE WAS
REFLECTING THE VIEWS OF PRESIDENT REAGAN AND THE ADMINISTRATION
