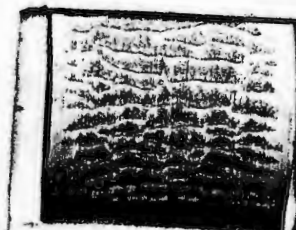
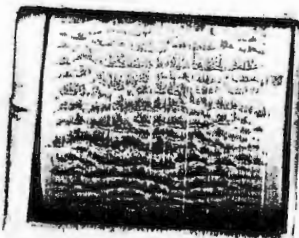

SUBJECT: Greek State Visit

As you may know, I was sent on a USICA Cultural Exchange (can you imagine me associated with Culture?) visit to Athens, Belgrade, Budapest, Prague and Paris during the last two weeks. (I had a chat with Sven Kramer who gave me the requisite number of words and, fortunately, I was not expelled or denounced anywhere.)

The one significant thing that I bring back to you is the fact that the Karamanlis Government is in deep trouble in Greece. Papandreou, an anti-American, anti-NATO, anti-EEC bad-hat was running 30% in the polls and climbing; while Karamanlis/Rallis were 35% and falling. There are dozens of problems in Greece and no one is certain who will win.

However, I was told by some of Karamanlis' folk that he needs bailing out and one way to do it would be for a formal invitation to him or Rallis (the Prime Minister) to come to Washington for a State visit prior to the election, probably scheduled for early fall.

It turns out that there has not been a formal state visit from any Greek since 1962 (they told me this and I have no way of verifying it).

I realize you must have 50 state visits waiting over there, but if we're to help save a supporter perhaps you should jack up the Greek visit.

Incidentally, Ambassador McCloskey agrees with my assessment and the visit request.


