Dear Mr. President:


I am writing to you as a friend, admirer and supporter. And, as a friend, I am not rushing to the press with this message, but would like it to reach you in a personal way.

Because I know of your deep sensitivity to the horrors suffered by the Jewish people during the Holocaust, your statement at the March 24 press conference explaining your decision not to visit the Dachau concentration camp, is totally out of character. It is obvious to me that you were ill-advised and misinformed.

First of all, clearly there are many thousands of German adults still alive who participated in the butchery of the Jewish people. Also, it is incredible, in the light of your own proven concern that the lesson of the Holocaust never be forgotten, you are now coming across as a person who seeks to expunge these memories.

I plead with you to avoid a totally superfluous and damaging confrontation with the Jewish community in this country, particularly since I am so confident that your press conference statement does not at all reflect your true sentiments. Please take immediate steps to include a visit to a concentration camp as part of your itinerary, so that the air be cleared and your true feelings publicly expressed and perceived.

1 Calling upon President Reagan to cancel a proposed visit to a
2 Nazi SS cemetery.

3 WHEREAS, During World War II, Nazi SS troops were largely
4 responsible for the implementation of Hitler's "Final Solution"
5 -- The Holocaust; and

6 WHEREAS, These Nazi SS troops, in addition to being
7 responsible for murdering over 6,000,000 Jews, were also
8 responsible for the death of several thousand American
9 servicemen and women; and

10 WHEREAS, This year is the 40th Anniversary of the end of
11 World War II and the liberation of Nazi concentration camps. It
12 is important to commemorate the victims and veterans of this war
13 and not its perpetrators; and

14 WHEREAS, President Reagan is planning a trip to a cemetery in
15 Bitburg, Germany, where Nazi SS Troops are buried; and

16 WHEREAS, This trip is insensitive and inappropriate for the
17 President of the United States; therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
2 call upon the President to cancel the visit to the Nazi SS
3 cemetery in Bitburg, Germany; and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That the Senate call upon the President to, in some
5 other way, demonstrate the friendship of the United States and
6 West Germany since World War II; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
8 the President of the United States.

Dear Mr. President Reagan:

I am a survivor of the Holocaust, a survivor of a deathcamp of 135 000 Jewish men, women and children with only 10 persons being alive at liberation. Your statement not to visit a former concentrationcamp during your visit to Germany has made me very sad and gave me the reason to write this letter.

During the Hitler years 6 million Jews and unknown millions of other prisoners including many anti-Nazi Germans were brutally murdered by the Gestapo, SS guards and their helpers.

Dachau, Buchenwald, Sachsenhausen and Flossenburg are the oldest concentrationcamps of the Hitler time and were build with the blood of German politcal prisoners, men and women alike. By visiting one of these former prisons you also honor the Germans who gave their lives for freedom and dignity and who fought against Hitler's dictatorship.

The present German Government has nothing to do with Nazi Germany, but the past cannot be wiped out. Many former Nazi's and SS guards are still alive and would feel very comfortable if you, Mr. President, will not honor the dead of the greatest tragedy of mankind.

This year will be the 40th anniversary of the end of World War II, the liberation of the concentrationcamps and the end of the massmurder. History has a way to repeat itself and only by speaking out against dictatorship, tyranny and massmurder can we hope to build a better world.

You, Sir, are the President of the greatest Nation on earth, the greatest democracy, the land of the free and the brave, the land of freedom and honor.


