Dear Mr. President:

The members of the entire Jewish community of Ocean County are deeply disturbed by and in total disagreement with the remarks you made at the recent Press Conference. When you were asked whether you would visit the infamous concentration camp Dachau during your proposed visit to West Germany in May, a 40th Anniversary of our victory over the Nazis and their allies in Europe, you responded by saying, "Instead of reawakening the memories and so forth, and the passions of the time, maybe we should observe this as a day when, forty years ago, peace began and friendship."

You know full well that all decent people in this world feel that the memories of the slaughter of millions of innocent men, women, and children, Jewish and otherwise, are those of an ineradicable tragically horrifying holocaust, the realities and lessons of which must not be forgotten by all of mankind. Your visit to Dachau would be a reminder to the world that our great and mighty nation will never permit such a frightful disaster to occur again to any of our fellow men anywhere in the world.

Your further remark that "since the German people have very few alive that remember even the war, and certainly none of them were adults and participating in any way, they have a feeling and a guilt feeling that's been imposed on them," is most inaccurate. It is belied by the fact that there are still many tens of thousands of Germans alive who were adults during the nightmare of Hitlarism who participated in the Holocaust or who stood idly by letting it happen. Your public

remarks will comfort them and make them feel confident that they have been forgiven because it is now your policy to forgive and forget.

As Jews we find it impossible to forget the cold-blooded slaughter of so many millions of our brothers and sisters. Neither should the people of Germany, old and young alike, be permitted to forget.

We urge that you reconsider your unacceptable remarks, that you withdraw them and that you, in fact, do visit Dachau as proof of our nation's unrelenting dedication to guaranteeing a world free of the evils perpetrated by Nazism in your time and mine. On behalf of the Ocean County Jewish Federation in Ocean County, New Jersey, I call upon you to change your remarks, your sentiments, and your actions in this matter.

Reagan Emson the Holocaust

Presidents Reagan, apparently believes that all originans alive today are under 60 years old. According to him, "very few." Germans today even remember, let alone took part in, the Second World War, and none of them "were adults and participating in any way" in the events of 40 years ago.

This is his rationale for not going to Dachau next month and not paying homage to the victims of Nazism. He is afraid that the German people's "unnecessary" guilt feelings would be aggravated if the President of the United States were to visit the site of a Nazi concentration camp. It would seem that a brief history lesson is in order

In 1943, when my parents arrived at Auschwitz, they were in their early 30's. Most of the German guards and doctors who tortured them and sent their families to the gas chambers were their age or younger. Similarly, many of the killers of Treblin

ka, Bergen-Belsen, Dachau and all the other death camps were in their, 20's and 30's when they participated in the annihilation of six million European Jews. Nazi Germany was, after all, youth-oriented. Relatively few of these mass murderers died in battle, and only a handful of them were executed for their crimes after the war. Thus, many of them are today in their 60's and 70's, still alive and well and living in Germany.

Josef Mengele, the notorious chief doctor of Auschwitz, for example, was two months younger than my father and a year and a half younger than my mother. Mengele is now 74 years old — exactly the same age as President Reagan. Somehow, I think Mengele remembers the Third Reich. So do his high school and university classmates.

Klaus Barbie, a Gestapo chief in Nazi-occupied France, who is now awaiting trial in a French jail, was born in 1915. Seven of the 22 defendants in the 1963 trial in Frankfurt of onetime Auschwitz SS men were also born after Mr. Reagan.

One frequently reads about the reunions that old SS gangs hold throughout Germany. When they meet, they reminisce about the good

old days — when men were men and Jews were subhuman — and proclaim anew their loyalty to the Führer Today, they must be in great spirits, After 40 years, the President of the United States has finally said that it is all right to forget all about them and their barbarous exploits.

But Nazi war criminals are not the only Germans who were adults between 1940 and 1945. West Germany's President, Richard von Weizsäcker, is 65 years old; the Bavarian Prime Minister, Franz Josef Strauss, is only 70. They, together with all the surviving veterans of Hitler's armed forces and storm troopers, bear at least a share of responsibility — if not personal guilt — for the Holocaust.

I do not mean to imply that all Germans were Nazis, or that any German born after 1945 should be held responsible for the Holocaust. The fact is, however, that Hitler's Final Solution of the "Jewish Question" was planned and implemented by the German Government in the name of the German people. The fact is, however, that Hitler's Final Solution of the 'Jewish Question was planned and implemented by the German Government in the name of the German people. Whatever President Reagan thinks, a nation's identity is the totality of its past, the bad as well as the good. Thus, the Holocaust is and must remain forever a part of the German national heritage.

None of this should really surprise President Reagan. He, too, remembers the war. Two years ago, he told a gathering of more than 15,000 Holocaust survivors. "Our most sacred task now is insuring that the memory of this greatest of human tragedies, the Holocaust, never fades,—that its lessons are not forgotten."

Why, then, his disingenuous excuse for not going to Dachau? The disturbing answer is that while it is politically advantageous for him to speak about the Holocaust to Jewish audiences in the United States, he does not want to risk offending anyone.—even Nazis — in Germany.

President Reagan's refusal to observe the 40th anniversary of the end of the Holocaust is morally offensive. Su He has made it clear that for him, the dead of Dachau, symbolic of the dead of all the Nazi concentration camps, are less worthy of respect than the fallen soldiers of Normandy on the G.F.'s who lie buried in Arlington National Cemetery. In essence, he is off telling the world that he cares more about confemporary German sensitholities than about the memory of Hiteston and the cares more respectively. However, the vehicle of continuance or symbol, while it may have been meant to show the Germans "the scars were healed" as far as German humiliation was concerned, did not stop to consider the feelings of all concerned with such a symbol (symbol meaning cemetary). The scars for the whole world in this regard can never be forgotten and the "subject of choice" was a poor one.

I truly believe that your intentions were only the best in the interest of world peace and my heart hurts for what you must be going through, the personal grief, that is.

Many times in the past, notorious individuals have cancelled trips because of security reasons. In this instance, so many citizens are emotionally riled up and there is so much discord, that such an excuse might not be out of line to cancel the whole "peace" part of the trip. Certainly, the German people would understand a situation such as that and the 40 years of peace could be celebrated in some other way. The whole thing seems to be "just a mistake" of choices.

I wish you nothing but the best, good health and continued success with the Presidency.
