- This paper is for advance informational purposes. Secretary Haig is generally aware of proposal for delegation, but has not yet passed on the specific individuals who he recommends make up this U.S. representational group:

- Facts:

1. The President has been invited to the September celebration (Tab 1).

2. At Bureau level, State Department has recommended sending a high level delegation - The Secretary's executive assistant indicates that it will be approved (Tab 2).

3. Swaziland Prime Minister Mabandla has announced that 4 September will be the main day of Diamond Jubilee and 22 heads of Government plus the U.N. have been invited (Tab 3 for message plus listing of countries).

4. We have been informed that British expect to send Princess Margaret (Tab 4).

5. The Minister of Home Affairs of Swaziland, who is responsible for the King's Diamond Jubilee will be in Washington May 11 and 12. Upon the Secretary's return from Brussels we will be sending the formal paper on the delegation ASAP.
