## "American Landscape"

by Tamar Fishman

"American Landscape," an original papercut by Washington artist Tamar Fishman, was designed and executed to mark the occasion of Israeli Prime Minister Menahem Begin's state visit with President Ronald Reagan, September 8-10, 1981. It is a contemporary example of an ancient art form. Papercutting probably originated in China, from which it spread to Persia and Turkey, and in the seventeenth century to Europe. During the nineteenth and twentieth centuries it became a popular craft among Jewish and other ethnic communities of Poland and central Europe. The dissemination of the technique and its adaptation by various cultures can be traced in written records and by examining rare and delicate papercuts in collections around the world.

The technique is basically one of cutting a pattern out of folded paper with a sharp knife so as to get a symmetrical design. As a folk art, the papercuts made use of designs and motifs that reflected the popular imagery and symbols which prevailed in the various communities. In the last few decades there has been a gradual revival of the art of papercutting. While respecting traditional patterns and techniques, contemporary artists have created papercuts that reflect their own distinctive forms of expression.

"American Landscape" integrates popular symbols of American history and traditions. The center of the papercut is a montage of the Washington skyline. It is surrounded by silhouettes of four symbols of American history -- the Liberty Bell, the Statue of Liberty, the Great Seal of the United States, and the Presidential Seal. These are supported by a symmetrical tracery embellished with popular American flora and fauna -- squirrels and bears, buffalo and deer, redwoods and dogwoods, various birds and the American eagle.
