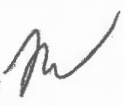

Malawi President H. Kamuzu Banda wrote the President on November 9 urging a total contribution to IDA VII of \$16 billion and a commensurate US contribution. The letter is similar to several others received from African leaders.

The proposed reply from State notes that we have urged the IDA management to have realistic expectations for IDA VII and states that the \$16 billion proposal is unrealistically high. It further notes the US position that resources must be used effectively and the need for recipient countries to adopt policies likely to lead to success. Our proposed contribution of \$750 million is then justified, and our continuing support of IDA is pledged.

The speechwriters have cleared the text. *W for* Roger Robinson concurs.

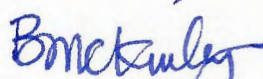
