SUBJECT: NATO Cooperation Projects -- Legislative Referral

This legislative referral action is now in about its fourth iteration. The argument boils down to a legal battle between Treasury and Defense. Treasury is trying to "protect" the law on waivers for foreign purchase, claiming that the proposed legislation grants discretionary powers to the Secretary of Defense that are too broad. Defense, unsurprisingly, argues the opposite. It is a battle over the nuances of the U.S.C. in which the NSC has long since voiced its policy position in favor of NATO cooperation.

The memorandum at Tab I reiterates the NSC position.


