The 1986 DoD Authorization Act (P.L. 99-145, Sec. 1411) required that the President report to Congress by 1 October 1986 on the results of consultations among NATO member nations concerning the organization's chemical deterrent posture. Your staff coordinated an extension of the due date. Attached is the required report with draft transmittal letter. I have also provided the Authorization language for your information.

The information contained in the report has been obtained from SHAPE. The NATO consultation process has been going on for many years. Progress has been made in chemical warfare defense. As ADM Crowe proposed to the NATO Military Committee, it is now time to evaluate what we have done and what remains to be done.

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
