EARLY INDICATIONS OF POSSIBLE FORCEDOWN: THE WATCH RECEIVED REPORTS BY CRITIC MESSAGES BEGINNING AT -1910 OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT THE KAL FLIGHT MIGHT HAVE BEEN FORCED DOWN IN THE VICINITY OF SAKHALIN ISLAND. FURTHER MESSAGES THAT CAME IN OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF HOURS - APPEARED TO CONFIRM THAT AN INCIDENT INDEED OCCURRED. AN INFORMAL TASK FORCE WAS CONSTITUTED IN THE OPERATIONS CENTER.

3. CONTACTS WITH THE SOVIETS: AMEMBASSY SEOUL INFORMED US BY TELEPHONE AT APPROXIMATELY 2335 THAT THE -SOUTH - KOREAN AUTHORITIES HAD REQUESTED THAT THE U.S. APPROACH THE SOVIETS WITH TWO QUESTIONS ON THE KAL FLIGHT: A) -DO THE SOVIETS HAVE ANY INFORMATION CONCERNING THE FATE OF THE KAL PLANE? AND B) OUR SEARCH ALONG THE PROGRAMMED FLIGHT PATH OF THE AIRCRAFT HAS BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL. -DO THE SOVIETS HAVE MORE ACCURATE COORDINATES REGARDING THE ACTUAL FLIGHT PATH TO ENABLE US TO DIRECTOUR EFFORTS IN THAT AREA?

4. ASSISTANT SECRETARY BURT SOUGHT TO CALL SOVIET CHARGE SOKOLOV MINUTES AFTER THE MESSAGE WAS RECEIVED FROM SEOUL. ALTHOUGH SOKOLOV WAS NOT IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE, THE QUESTIONS WERE PASSED TO THE EMBASSY DUTY OFFICER TO BE SENT TO MOSCOW. SOKOLOV CALLED BURT BACK AT 2410. BURT THEN REPEATED THE MESSAGE TO HIM, EMPHASIZING THE URGENCY WITH WHICH WE NEEDED THE INFORMATION AND TELLING SOKOLOV THAT AN AMERICAN CONGRESSMAN WAS APPARENTLY AMONG THE AMERICANS ON THE AIRPLANE. WE CALLED CHARGE ZIMMERMANN IN MOSCOW TO ASK HIM TO CONVEY THIS MESSAGE URGENTLY TO THE SOVIET FOREIGN MINISTRY. WE ALSO INFORMED THE SOVIET MFA THAT THE U.S. HAD SEARCH AND RESCUE ASSETS AVAILABLE THAT COULD BE IN THE AREA WITHIN HOURS. OUR CHARGE REPORTED BACK THAT THE FOREIGN MINISTRY'S USA DEPARTMENT CHIEF BESSMERTNYKH SAID HE HAD NO INFORMATION ON THE PLANE BUT HE AGREED TO CHECK ON IT. BESSMERTNYKH CALLED THE CHARGE BACK AT APPROXIMATELY

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0230 ASKING FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THE FLIGHT. THEN AT 0430 WASHINGTON TIME, BESSMERTNYKH CALLED WITH THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE: "THE PLANE HAS NOT BEEN LOCATED ON SOVIET TERRITORY. THE COMPETENT SOVIET ORGANS ARE TAKING NECESSARY MEASURES TO SEARCH FOR IT OUTSIDE SOVIET TERRITORY."

5. PRESS COVERAGE OF THE INCIDENT BEGAN AROUND 2300. INITIAL SPECULATION FOLLOWED THE LINES OF A REPORT FROM SEOUL THAT THE PLANE HAD BEEN FORCED TO LAND ON SAKHALIN ISLAND AND NEGOTIATIONS WERE UNDERWAY TO ENSURE THE RELEASE OF THE PASSENGERS. THIS LINE BECAME UNTENABLE WHEN THE SOUTH KOREANS LATER DENIED THE STORY AND A JAPANESE REPORT FROM MOSCOW SAID A SOVIET FOREIGN MINISTRY OFFICIAL HAD DENIED THAT THE PLANE WAS ON THE ISLAND. TASS RUSSIAN CARRIED AN ITEM AT 0205 NOTING THAT A SOUTH KOREAN BOEING-747 HAD "DISAPPEARED WITHOUT A TRACE" ON A FLIGHT FROM NEW YORK TO SEOUL. WE HAD TOLD THE PRESS THROUGHOUT THE EVENING THAT THERE WERE MANY CONFLICTING STORIES ON WHAT HAPPENED TO THE PLANE AND THAT WE HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH THE SOVIETS HERE AND IN MOSCOW ASKING FOR INFORMATION ON IT.

6. AT APPROXIMATELY 0330, CINCPAC ORDERED AN HC-130 SEARCH AND RESCUE-PLANE TO THE AREA IN WHICH THE PLANE WENT DOWN. THE MISSION WAS TO COMENCE AT 0730 WASHINGTON TIME, TO LAST FOUR AND ONE-HALF HOURS, AND TO COVER A SEVENTY-MILE LONG BOX NO CLOSER THAN THIRTY-TWO NM TO SOVIET TERRITORY. WE INFORMED THE SOVIETS THROUGH CHARGE ZIMMERMANN OF THIS MISSION, INCLUDING

COORDINATES, TO REDUCE THE CHANCE OF AN INCIDENT DURING RESCUE EFFORTS BY THE TWO SIDES.
