#### I. PURPOSE

To permit the Republican leaders to brief the President on the status of House Republican deficit reduction efforts, and to give the Administration an opportunity to relate to the House Republican leaders their activities to put together a package.

#### II. BACKGROUND

On Monday, March 12, 1984, the President met with Republican leaders to discuss deficit reduction efforts. Since that meeting, the House Republican leaders have met with House Republicans to obtain their recommendations for a deficit reduction package.

These meetings have produced no clear consensus on what should be done or how it should be accomplished. There is general agreement that Republicans should develop a positive proposal, but there are divergent views as to the appropriate components of such a package. Bob Michel, the Republican Leader, will meet with House Republican Members of the Budget Committee on Thursday, March 15, 1984, to discuss various recommendations provided by Members.

The Republican leadership continues to feel it is important to have Republican unity on a deficit reduction package so they can effectively counter a Democratic budget proposal. It is still likely that the House Budget Committee will begin to mark up the First Budget Resolution the week of March 19, 1984.
