SUBJECT: Finland

Thanks for your memo of March 13 on Finland and the question of extending an official invitation to President Koivisto. Your thoughts are particularly timely in light of Koivisto's projected travel to the U.S. during the first half of October, when he plans to participate in the U.N. General Assembly. In addition, the Finns have been giving some consideration to having their President help inaugurate the large "Scandinavia Today" exhibit which will open in Washington in September; this might also be an appropriate occasion for extending an official invitation (though the anticipated presence of other Scandinavian leaders may well complicate both the practical and the protocolary aspects of that contingency).

In any event, I am ensuring that the NSC staff and State are looking into your idea - a very good one - and carefully weighing it against the other official visit priorities we are now juggling for the rest of this year and early next.

I appreciate your interest.

In view of the importance of maintaining an appropriate balance in U.S. and Soviet relations with Finland, it might be well to consider extending an opportunity to President Koivisto to visit the United States, not necessarily soon, but an invitation and groundwork could begin shortly.

2. THE DCM CALLED ON MFA POLITICAL DIRECTOR PIETINEN JULY 26 TO CONVEY THE INFORMATION IN PARA 2, REFTEL, AND TO OBTAINING APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED PRESS ANNOUNCEMENT SET FORTH IN PARA 3 THEREOF. THIS IS AN ACTION MESSAGE; SEE PARA 6, BELOW.

3. PIEPNEN STATED THAT THE GOF HAD NO OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED ANNOUNCEMENT. WITH REGARD TO TIMING OF THE RELEASE, HE SAID "THE SOONER THE BETZR," IN VIEW OF THE PROSPECT OF LEAKS WHICH WOULD DETRACT FROM THE EFFECTIVENESS OF A SIMULTANEOUS RELEASE IN CAPITALS. PIETINEN THAN RECOMXNDED RELEASE ON THURSDAY, JULY 28 AT 1000 HOURS WASHINGTON TIME (1700 HOURS LOCAL).

4. PIETENEN SAID THAT THE OVERALL PLANS FOR PRSIDENT KOIVISTO'S VISIT TO THE U. S. ARE "NOT YET COMPLETELY CLEAR" BUT WHEN THE "OUTLINES" HAVE BEEN SKETCHED, THE MFA WOULD BE BAK IN TOUCH WITH THE EMBASSY. THE GOF PLANS TO ISSUE ITS OWN STATEMENT CONCERNING THE NON-WASHINGTON PORTIONS OF THE KOIVISTO VISIT.

5. PIETINEN NOTED THAT KOIVISTO WOULD DEFINITELY BE GOING TO NEW YORK FOR THE UNGA. IN RESPONSE TO A QUERY FROM THE DCM, PIETINEN SAID THAT INDIRA GANDHI'S SO-CALLED "SUMMIT MEETING" WOULD RPT WOULD TAKE PLACE IN A "RATHER LIMITED FORM." IT APPEARED FROM PIEPNEN'S COMMENTS THAT APPROXIMATELY TEN OF THE NNA HAVE DECIDED TO PARTICIPATE AND WILL MEET BILATERALLY OR IN "SMALL GROUPS."



Dear Mr. Foley:

The White House has asked the Department to respond to your letter of October 12, 1983 concerning an inquiry from your constituent, Mr. Robert E. Howell, about the cancellation of the US visit of Finnish President Mauno Koivisto.

Apparently, Mr. Howell's daughter was misinformed about the schedule for President Koivisto's visit to the United States, it was not cancelled but took place September 24 - October 3 as originally planned.

When this visit was first scheduled, a meeting for President Koivisto with President Reagan was arranged for September 26. Shortly before President Koivisto's departure from Helsinki, it was decided that President Reagan would address the opening session of the United Nations General Assembly on September 26. This decision was communicated to the Finnish government. We did not request or suggest that the visit be cancelled. The meeting of the two Presidents was subsequently rescheduled for September 27. There was no disruption of the remainder of President Koivisto's US schedule.

We believe the visit was a successful one. It was a public demonstration that neutral Finland, despite the sensitivity of its geo-political situation, can maintain close economic, commercial, and cultural ties to the West and to the United States in particular.

I hope you find this information useful in responding to Mr. Howell.



Our daughter writes that her Finnish mother, who is a well-educated woman, believes that the U.S. does not trust Finland's neutrality and does not want President Korvisto in the U.S. because Finland has too many ties with the Soviet Union. She also reports that many people in Finland are hurt and offended by your decision and they feel it was not wise. We are enraged with the Soviets' shooting down of the Korean jet liner and support the position you have taken with regard to the tragedy, but we cannot understand why you would associate Finland with this incident.
