SUBJECT: Meeting of the President with Former French President Giscard d'Estaing

Al Haig strongly recommends that the President meet with Giscard in Grand Rapids. Giscard is one of the senior Western statesmen; he heads the opposition party in France, a party which is ideologically closer to the Reagan administration than Mitterrand's governing party.

I share Al's views on the desirability of such a meeting. From the long-term standpoint of US-French relations, it would be unfortunate if the President were unable to meet with Giscard. I recommend a short meeting, even only a brief handshake/photo-op if that is all that is possible.

Meeting of the President with Former French SUBJECT: President Giscard d'Estaing

NSC has been asked for its recommendation on the request by Giscard to meet with the President. We share State's view that since they are both going to be in Grand Rapids, the President should receive Giscard for a brief meeting. To do otherwise would be a snub not just to (oversensitive) French pride, and would be breaking the rules of the association of present and former presidents, but would offend Horace work out of south of the the guy who heads the party in France ideologically closest to us, and who may yet return as a force in France.

- He holds down a number of more or less significant functions in the Senate, including Secretary of the Senate (main job); Secretary of the Commission for Social Affairs (involved in social reform, where he can be in a position to impede some of the Mitterrand people's wilder ideas); and Vice President of the Senate study group on cooperation and friendship with Saudi Arabia.
- He is married and has five children.
- Reputed to be very bright, and has, despite his formal functions, a special interest in agricultural matters (is a Chevalier de l'Agriculture).



BIOGRAPHY - Bernard Vernier-Palliez

France

Bernard Vernier-Palliez' appointment in 1975 as Renault's President and Director-General capped a long career at Renault that began shortly after the company was nationalized following World War II. He joined Renault in 1945, serving as Secretary of the Board of Directors, Secretary-General, and as Assistant Director-General. From 1967 to 1975, he was Director-General of SAVIEM, and he engineered a merger between SAVIEM and Berliet, another producer of vehicles.

During Vernier-Palliez' tenure as Director-General, Renault's profits exceeded one billion francs making the company the most profitable of France's nationalized (pre-Mitterrand) industries. Renault also became the largest selling automobile in Europe. Vernier-Palliez was one of the forces behind Renault's decision to enter the U.S. automobile market by obtaining a large minority holding in American Motors. Vernier-Palliez was preceded as President and Director-General of Renault by Pierre Dreyfuss who was named Minister of Industry in June 1981. He is personally acquainted with President Mitterrand and Minister of External Relations, Claude Cheysson.

A frequent visitor to the United States, Vernier-Palliez was recently elected President of the Franco-American Chamber of Commerce. He likes Americans and admires their approach to solving problems. Through him, France will attempt to change its image from that of a producer of luxury goods to one that emphasizes good business practices. The French Government believes he will be an effective spokesman for its economic policies.

Vernier-Palliez was born in Tours in 1918. He studied law, political science, and commerce in Paris, and earned medals for valor for his services during World War II. He married Denise Silet-Pathe in 1952. They have four children. An intensely private man, he and his wife have avoided the Paris social whirl with determination. He enjoys classical music, opera, and horseback riding. He speaks excellent English.

A thorough search of U.S. Government sources reveals no grounds for objection.





Subject: Effort by Gaullist Leader Chirac to Meet with the President

Former French Ambassador to the United States <u>Kosciusko-Morizet</u>, who is now foreign policy advisor to Paris Mayor and Gaullist Leader Jacques Chirac, plans to be in Yorktown for the bicentennial ceremonies. It is possible that he may approach you or other members of the President's staff to try to arrange a call on the President by Chirac later this year. Chirac plans to visit New York, and hopes to come to Washington for such a meeting.

We do not believe it would be wise for the President to see Chirac at this time. Neither President Mitterrand nor Chirac's rival, former President Giscard, will have been received by the President at the White House. Both would be offended if Chirac were to be the first French visitor the President sees in Washington. If Chirac seeks a meeting we recommend that he call on the Vice President, but not the President.


