His Excellency Shimon Peres, Prime Minister of Israel, will arrive at the Diplomatic Entrance. You will escort the Prime Minister to the James Monroe Room via your private elevator.

Cocktails will be served.

7:40 p.m.

Mr. Bill Davis, Manager of the Eighth Floor, and I will escort you to the John Quincy Adams Room. The receiving line will form across from the fireplace as follows: You, the Prime Minister, and Mrs. Shultz. I will assist with the introductions. (Note: a photographer will be available to take pictures.) Press will be present. You and Mrs. Shultz may mingle with your guests once the receiving line concludes.

Cocktails will be served. A string ensemble from the United States Marine Band will play during the reception period.

8:10 p.m.

After the guests move to their tables in the Benjamin Franklin Room, you, Mrs. Shultz, and the Prime Minister will be announced. You and Mrs. Shultz will escort the Prime Minister to your table. Mr. Davis will lead the way.

Dinner will be served. The Ambassadors, a combo from the United States Air Force, will play during the dinner period.

9:20 p.m. Dessert, champagne, and coffee will be served. The United States Army Strolling Strings will perform.

9:50 p.m. Following the Strolling Strings, you may make your toast. The Prime Minister will respond.

10:15 p.m. Your dinner concludes. You and Mrs. Shultz will escort the Prime Minister to the Diplomatic Entrance for his departure.

U.S. Catholic Official **Explains** Vatican's Nonrecognition of Israel

key Vatican official indicated A last week that Jewish leaders are deluding themselves if they believe the Vatican will extend diplomatic recognition to Israel before the Jewish state agrees to resolve the question of Jerusalem along lines acceptable to the Papacy.

Dr. Eugene Fisher, executive secretary for the Vatican Secretariate for Catholic-Jewish Relations, told the Jewish World, that "The status of Jerusalem must be internationally guaranteed. As long as the issue of Jerusalem is unresolved, the Vatican will not play its most valuable card, which is a diplomatic exchange with Israel."

Fisher's comments - coming in the wake of the broiling controversy over the Vatican's insistence that New York Archbishop John Cardinal O'Connor cancel his planned meetings in Jerusalem last week with Prime Minister Yitzhak Shamir and President Chaim Herzog - vividly pointed up the reality that despite 20 years of fruitful and cordial dialogue between the Vatican and world Jewry, which has led to unprecedented Catholic efforts to uproot

long-ingrained anti-Semitism within the Church, the two sides are still sharply divided over the issue of Israel.

The revelation of the continuing Vatican refusal to accord diplomatic recognition to Israel, has led to a renewed debate within the Jewish community over whether Jews ought to press forward with dialogue with Catholics on other issues of joint concern.

Fisher, who has met frequently over the years with members of IJCIC (the International Jewish Committee on Interreligious Consultations - the official body of world Jewry designated to meet with Vatican leadership), is seen by Jewish leaders as among the Vatican spokesmen most sympathetic both to world Jewry and to the state of Israel

In his comments, Fisher acknowledged that, "Catholics need to increase their understanding of the centrality of Israel to the Jewish religion and to world Jewry, just as we need to increase our understanding of the 'Shoah.'"

Noting that he is aware of Jewish impatience with the position of the Papacy on the question of Israel, Fisher remarked. "It should be noted, however, that there have been some significant advances over the years by the Vatican. When Pope Paul VI came (to Israel) in 1965, he never once uttered the phrase 'State of Israel.' The present Pope, by comparison, speaks about the state of Israel frequently, has condemned terrorism directed against Israel, and has acknowledged Israel's right to security and tranquility."

Fisher also noted that the Vatican has left purposely ambiguous what solution it will settle for on the Jerusalem question, as well as on the Palestinian issue.

Fisher added, "The Vatican is not criticizing Israeli administration of the Holy Places. But given the flux in the Middle East, it is clear the Vatican wants a solution sealed into international law. They are thinking in terms of the ages. They also want a situation where, even if Meir Kahane gets elected mayor of Jerusalem, he would not be able to upset the balance that has been established."

Fisher noted, however, that the Vati-

can no longer speaks L status" for Jerusalem, but ratner . ternational statute." He explained, ' this we mean that whoever has sove. eignty over Jerusalem would have to upholding internationally agreed-upon principles. International statute would not preclude Israeli sovereignty, but would not see that as the only solution."

Fisher admitted that he was surprised that the Vatican had objected to O'Connor visiting the offices of Shamir and Herzog, since those offices are in West Jerusalem. He added, "West Jerusalem has not been an issue for the Vatican. What they have objected to has been the unilateral Israeli annexation of East Jerusalem."

Fisher also indicated that Vatican fear of a potential bloodbath of Catholic minorities in Arab countries has played an important role in its aloof attitude toward Israel.

"Certainly whatever the Vatican does vis-a-vis Israel has implications for Catholic minorities. Certainly, the interests of those minorities are not served by a state of war between Israel and her Arab neighbors," he explained.

Fisher said that at present, the impact of the O'Connor controversy on the overall framework of Catholic-Jewish relations is "hard to assess." It depends on what happens during O'Connor's visit in Israel. It should be noted that this controversy has brought to the center of the Catholic-Jewish dialogue the question of Israel, and I think that is a healthy development."
