The decision has been made to submit to the Congress an FY1984 supplemental appropriation request for military construction at Ras Banas, Egypt. As you will recall, that project has been under consideration for several years, and previously had been funded in the FY1983 budget for \$91 million. That appropriation was recently rescinded by the MILCON conference, but without prejudice, and the conferees further invited a supplemental request if a detailed comprehensive proposal for proceeding with Ras Banas could be prepared.

There is attached a paper which reviews the history of
the Ras Banas project, provides explanation of the military and
political rationale for that concept, covers joint construction
plans and addresses concerns which have been voiced in the past.

I think you will find that package to be of use to you as you
consider the supplemental request which has been forwarded separately.

The administration is still convinced that Ras Banas must be an
important part of our continuing efforts to build a viable strategy
in Southwest Asia.

I solicit your perusal of this package, and welcome any questions you might have on any aspect of Ras Banas. Please convey directly to me any desire for further information you might have. Thank you for your attention in this matter.



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



Making supplemental appropriations for military construction for the Department of the Air Force for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1984, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in addition to the monies appropriated by the Military 3 Construction Appropriation Act, 1984, Pub.
