Thursday, May 27, 1982, 11:00 a.m., Room 305

You are scheduled to make some introductory remarks to a group of visiting Indian leaders. The group includes some prestigous members of the Indian establishment. Generally speaking they have a strong pro-US bias. The following are suggested talking points for you to use. I will follow up with more detailed comments:

- -- We are delighted to welcome you to the National Security Council. When the President met with Mrs. Ghandi at Cancun last year, we agreed that closer relations between United States and India were in both our countries interests. This is never more true today. We will reaffirm this when Mrs. Ghandi visits Washington at the end of July.
- -- It is a pity that the great bonds that unite our two countries--democracy and common, shared values--have often been overshadowed by disputes. However, the more I talk with Indians, the more I realize that our differences can and must be overcome. We have far too much at stake together in the world to allow our differences to continue to divide us.
- -- As you know, U.S.-India economic relations have been improving and we have great respect for the economic achievements of your country, which I understand has one of the more remarkable growth records for any country in the world in recent years.
- -- We all know that the major problem in U.S.-India relations is the question of our arms sale to Pakistan. Actually, it is not our arms sale to Pakistan, per se, but rather the specific weapons systems we have been committed to sell including F-16s.
- -- Our support of Pakistan stems from the great dangers we see in Southwest Asia and the threat posed by the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. We think it unfortunate that the Indian Government has to be so quiet on Afghanistan: I understand privately that most Indians are appalled by what the Soviets are doing. We believe that in view of the Soviet presence in Afghanistan something must be done to help Pakistan and we intend to do this. We would much prefer to consult and work with you and help to improve Indo-Pakistan relations so that we can remove this problem from our agenda.

-- In the long run, I am confident that we can work out a much closer relationship and that this can be of benefit to both of us. Let me now turn to Geoffrey Kemp for follow-up questions and remarks.
