This is a fairly sensitive memo. If leaked, it could convey the impression that we granted the waiver without regard to the merits (which are not treated in the memo).

As a separate but related matter, the memore does not say what the criterion for granting a waiver is. That is, "in the national interest...or ...would promote our national security...or...assuring that nothing bad would happen if we did."

I assume that the criterion iwll not be a problem but we ought to know what it is.

I recommend that we handle this by briefing the President at a 9:30 after the Judge has talked to Shultz to get his sense of whether this si something they want to do--(I'm sure it is). If so, then State ought to send over a PD on the issue for the Judge to handle in a 9:30 meeting. But we ought not be giving directed guidance in writing on a canned PD. For the Judge to set this in motion with his call to Shultz we need a little more: infor (on what basis does the Pres grant the waiver--the criterion).


