



SUBJECT: The U.S. Position on ADB Loans to India

At yesterday's IG, it became clear that the Treasury is going to fight very hard against State's proposal to support loans of up to \$400 million for India through the period 1984 - 1987 at the upcoming directors' meeting of the Asian Development Bank. Since this issue is so important in the context of our bilateral relations with India and touches on many institutional concerns in Treasury, it's important that we resolve the question before the August 24 meeting.

At Tab I is a tasker from you to the State and Treasury requesting that they prepare papers setting out their respective positions on this subject to be sent to us no later than August 17. In the event that there are irreconcilable differences between the two, we should prepare cover papers and send them to the President for decision.

SUBJECT: The U.S. Position on ADB Loans to India

At the IG meeting on August 14 at the State Department on NSSD 3-84 regarding U.S. relations with India and Pakistan, it became clear that there are differences of opinion between State and Treasury over the level of loans that we should support for India in the upcoming ADB meetings on this subject. Because a meeting of the Directors of the ADB is scheduled for August 24, it is important that the Administration reach an agreed position on the levels of ADB lending for India by that time. State and Treasury should prepare papers for NSC consideration no later than close of business August 17. (C)
