SECRETARY OF STATE'S REWARDS AUTHORITY IN CASES OF INTERNALTONAL TERRORISM

Section 102 of the 1984 Act to Combat International Terrorism (P.L. 98-533) added a new section 36 to the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 (the "Act") (22 U.S.C. 2708) providing the Secretary of State with authority to pay a reward of not more than \$500,000 to any individual who furnishes information leading to:

- (a) "... the arrest or conviction, in any country, of any individual for the commission of an act of international terrorism, or"
- (b)"... the arrest or conviction, in any country, of any individual for conspiring or attempting to commit an act of international terrorism, or"

(c)"... the prevention, frustration, or favorable resolution of an act of international terrorism,

"if the act of international terrorism is against a United States person or United States property and is primarily outside the territorial jurisdiction of the United States."

A reward of \$100,000 or more "may not be made without the approval of the President or the Secretary of State personally."

Although the authorizing legislation contains no definition of the term "act of terrorism", the companion authority provided to the Attorney General to pay rewards for information in cases of domestic terrorism by section 101(a) of P.L. 98-533 contains the following definition of this term, which the legislative history indicates is intended to apply in the international context to the Secretary of State's authority as well:

"...the term 'act of terrorism' means an activity that-"(A) involves a violent act or an act dangerous to
human life that is a violation of the criminal laws of the
United States or of any State, or that would be a violation
if committed within the jurisdiction of the United States
or of any State; and

"(B) appears to be intended--

"(i) to intimidate or coerce a civilian population;

"(ii) to influence the policy of a
government by intimidation or coercion; or
 "(iii) to affect the conduct of a government
by assassination or kidnaping."

Subsection 36(c) of the Act provides that the Secretary shall "advise and consult with the Attorney General" before making a reward "in a matter over which there is Federal criminal jurisdiction." In practice, this will mean that consultation with the Department of Justice will usually be required before making a reward in any matter involving

threatened, attempted, or actual attack on U.S. Government personnel or facilities overseas, or involving certain other categories of violent acts over which the United States, pursuant to international convention or otherwise, exercises global criminal jurisdiction, such as hostage-taking or hijacking or sabotage of civil aircraft.

Pursuant to subsection 36(d) of the Act, any reward granted under this authority must be certified for payment by the Secretary. That subsection also gives the Secretary authority, if he determines that "the identity of the recipient of a reward or of the members of the recipient's immediate family must be protected," to "take such measures in connection with the payment of the reward as he deems necessary to effect such protection."

Subsection 36(e) of the Act provides that "an officer or employee of a governmental entity who, while in the performance of his or her official duties," furnishes information, "shall not be eligible for a reward under this section." This applies both to U.S. and foreign government officers and employees at all levels of government.

Detailed procedures for the administration of the rewards program have been drafted and cleared and are now with the Foreign Affairs Information Management Office for preparation for final publication in the Foreign Affairs Manual. These procedures will also be sent to all diplomatic posts.

Five million dollars were authorized for use in paying rewards under this law for FY 1985, of which one million have actually been appropriated. The Department has a supplemental request currently before the appropriations committees.
