- 4. REQUEST EMBASSY PARIS MAKE NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS TO ENSURE ALL PASSENGERS CAN DISEMBARK. REQUEST EMBASSY PARIS CONTACT GREEK EMBASSY AS WELL.
- 5. LATE NEWS IS THAT TWO UNIDENTIFIED WOMEN HAVE BEEN RELEASED FROM THE AIRPLANE, ONE ON A STRETCHER, BOTH REPEAT BOTH ARE AT ALGIERS AIRPORT. PLANS ARE TO PUT BOTH THESE WOMEN ON THE SCHEDULED 1350 FLIGHT TO PARIS. REQUEST PARIS HAVE APPROPRIATE MEDICAL PERSONNEL AVAILABLE TO MEET THEM ON ARRIVAL. NEWLIN BT



AT APPROXIMATELY 1445 ATHENS TIME (1145 GMT), THE GREEK MFA ADVISED THE EMBASSY THAT AN OLYMPIC AIRLINE AIRCRAFT HAD LEFT ATHENS APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES EARLIER CARRYING ALI ATWA TO ALGIERS. THE MFA STATED THAT THE GOG HAD ACTED AFTER CONSULTATIONS WITH THE ALGERIAN GOVERNMENT WHICH BELIEVES THAT THIS ACTION MAY HELP IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE TERRORISTS. THE MFA HAD NO ETA BUT ESTIMATED THE FLIGHT TIME AT THREE HOURS (WE UNDER-STAND FLIGHT TIME IS CLOSER TO TWO AND A HALF HOURS). STEARNS BT



- 2. HEREWITH IS PRELIMINARY REPORT ON ACTIVITIES AND CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING HIJACKING OF TWA FLIGHT 847 ON JUNE 14 REPEAT JUNE 14. INFORMATION IS BASED ON PUBLIC STATEMENTS BY GOG AND INFORMATION SUPPLIED SO FAR BY GREEK POLICE AND AIRLINE OFFICIALS.
- 3. IT APPEARS THAT TWO SUSPECTED HIJACKERS, SOMIR SALWAN AND GHOLEB AL-HOBBI (ELKOBBI). TOGETHER WITH ACCOMPLICE ALI ATWA, APPREHENDED BY GREEK AUTHORITIES, ARRIVED IN ATHENS ON A MIDDLE EAST AIRLINES FLIGHT FROM BEIRUT ON JUNE 13. WE KNOW FROM TWA RESERVATION LIST THAT AL HOBBI AND SALWAN HAD CONFIRMED RESERVATIONS ON TWA 847 DEPARTING ATHENS JUNE 14. (TWA OFFICIALS INDICATE THAT COMPUTER INFORMATION ON RESERVATIONS CAN ONLY BE OBTAINED THROUGH TWA OFFICIALS IN NEW YORK AS IT NO LONGER AVAILABLE IN ATHENS.) GREEK AND TWA OFFICIALS CONFIRM THAT SUSPECTED TWO TERRORISTS PASSED THROUGH GREEK AND TWA SECURITY

APPARENTLY THEIR ACCOMPLICE, ALI ATWA, WHO WAS LATER APPREHENDED AT AIRPORT BY GREEK POLICE, ALSO INTENDED TO TAKE TWA FLIGHT BUT WAS UNABLE TO BOARD AS HE DID NOT HAVE RESERVATION AND FLIGHT WAS FULL.

4. GREEK OFFICIALS HAVE INDICATED PUBLICLY THAT THE TWO LEBANESE PASSED THROUGH SCREENING FACILITIES BY WRAPPING THE PISTOL, AMMUNITION AND HAND GRENADES IN "PIECES OF FIBERGLASS." ACCORDING TO THE SEMI-OFFICIAL NEWS AGENCY, THE GREEK GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCED JUNE 14 THAT ALL PASSENGERS HAD BEEN SEARCHED BOTH BY GREEK AIRPORT AUTHORITIES AS WELL AS TWA OFFICIALS AND THAT THE SECURITY CHECKS BY CERTAIN AIRLINES IN CONJUNCTION WITH, AND WITH THE PERMISSION OF, THE GOG WAS DONE IN ORDER TO AVERT HIJACKINGS. THE GOG SPOKESMAN ALSO NOTED THAT IN THE IMMEDIATE PAST TWO AIRPLANES DEPARTING FRANKFURT SITUATION OF THE WELL KNOWN STRICT SECURITY MEASURES TAKEN BY THE WEST GERMAN AUTHORITIES."

5. WHILE THE GREEKS STILL HAVE A LONG WAY TO GO BEFORE AIRPORT SECURITY BECOMES TRULY EFFECTIVE. THEY HAVE BROUGHT ABOUT A DEGREE OF IMPROVEMENT. DEVOTED CONSIDERABLY MORE ATTENTION TO THE PROBLEM THAN BEFORE OUR CONSECUTIVE APPROACHES, AND DEMONSTRATED AN INCREASING WILLINGNESS TO COOPERATE WITH THE U.S. AS CONCERNS INFORMATION EXCHANGE, RECEPTIVENESS TO EXPERT ADVICE, TRAINING, ETC. THE SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEWLY ELECTED GOVERNMENT HAS ALREADY SHOWN ITS SENSITIVITY TO ANTICIPATED CRITICISM BY MAKING THE HIGHLY DEFENSIVE REMARKS CITED ABOVE ABOUT TWA SCREENING IN ATHENS AND AIRPORT SECURITY LAPSES ELSEWHERE. ISSUANCE OF A TRAVEL ADVISORY OR CRITICAL PUBLIC REMARKS FROM WASHINGTON IN THE WAKE OF THE TWA HIJACKING WOULD SURELY JEOPARDIZE OUR ABILITY TO INFLUENCE GREEK ATTITUDES AND ACTIONS FAVORABLY AND CAST FUTURE COOPERATION IN DOUBT. MOREOVER, IT APPEARS FROM MESSAGE TRAFFIC THAT THE GREEKS MAY BE IN A POSITION TO SUPPORT U.S. OBJECTIVES IN THE CURRENT TWA CASE, E.G., IN DAMASCUS, AND THAT THEY ARE MOTIVATED TO DO SO BY THE PRESENCE OF GREEK NATIONALS AMONG THE HIJACKING VICTIMS.

6. FOR BOTH SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM REASONS, THEREFORE, WE RECOMMEND AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF A TRAVEL ADVISORY OR OTHER PUBLIC ACTIONS OR COMMENTS AT THIS TIME. FOR NOW, WE SHOULD EXPRESS OUR CONCERNS PRIVATELY IN AN EFFORT TO CLOSE THE SECURITY GAPS AND BUILD ON PROGRESS ACHIEVED WITH THE GREEKS OVER THE PAST MONTHS. STEARNS

FYI: AS A CONDITION OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE OF THE TWA OFFER, THE AMCITS OBTAINED AN EXPLICIT GUARANTEE FROM TWA HEADQUARTERS IN PARIS (VIA TWA ATHENS AGENT LANGER) THAT TWA WOULD PUT THEM UP IN PARIS UNTIL THE END OF THE CRISIS. 

- 11. THAT SAID, WE OF COURSE HAVE NO GUARANTEE AS TO HOW MUCH BARRI WILL DO OR WILL BE ABLE TO DO IF THE AIRCRAFT COMES THIS WAY. HIS REFERENCE TO THE HIJACKING AS A "TRAP" FOR HIM AND TO HIZBALLAH INVOLVEMENT ARE FOOD FOR THOUGHT. AT LEAST PART OF THE "TRAP" MAY BE BARRI'S CONTINUING CONCERN THAT ANYTHING HE APPARENTLY DOES "FOR OR WITH THE AMERICANS" CAN BE USED AGAINST HIM BY HIS COMPETITORS.
- 12. PER REFTELCON, WE WILL CONTINUE TO INSIST IN ALL OUR CONTACTS THAT AIRCRAFT NOT/NOT BE PERMITTED TO LAND AT BEIRUT AIRPORT SHOULD IT HEAD HERE AGAIN.



SUBJECT: ICRC INVOLVEMENT IN THE TWA HIJACKING

- CONFIDENTIAL ENTIRE TEXT.
- AT US REQUEST ICRC WILL DISPATCH A FIVE-MEMBER TEAM FROM GENEVA TO ALGIERS TO ASSIST IN THE RESOLUTION OF THE TWA HIJACKING. THE TEAM WILL DEPART AT 2200 HOURS LOCAL JUNE 15 VIA A CHARTERED AIRCRAFT. WE ARE INFORMED BY THE ICRC THAT THE ALGERIAN GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN NOTIFIED AND HAS GIVEN ALL NECESSARY CLEARANCES FOR THE TEAMS TRAVEL.
- ICRC IS TAXING THIS ACTION WITHOUT MAKING A FORMAL DECISION TO INTERVENE. ICRC HAS APPROVED THE DEPARTMENT'S ISSUANCE OF A PRESS RELEASE WHICH STATES THAT ICRC HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE US AND ALGERIAN GOVERNMENTS AND IS NOW CONSIDERING HOW IT WILL ACT IN THIS MATTER. ICRC HAS TOLD US THAT THE DEPARTURE OF THE TEAM IS NOT A SECRET AND ICRC IS WILLING TO ANSWER QUESTIONS FROM THE PRESS ON ITS MISSION IS NOW IN PROCESS OF MOTIVATING ACTIVITIES. INQUIRIES FROM THE GENEVA BASED INTERNATIONAL PRESS.
- 4. ICRC HAS ALSO TOLD US THAT UNDER ITS INTERNAL REGULATIONS IT HAS THREE CONDITIONS FOR FORMAL INVOLVEMENT IN AIRCRAFT HIJACKING. THESE CONDITIONS ARE:
- -DIRECT REQUESTS FROM ALL PARTIES IN THE INCIDENT (I.E. THE US AND ALGERIAN GOVERNMENTS AND THE HIJACKERS);
- --KNOWLEDGE THAT NO OTHER AUTHORITIES ARE IN CONTACT WITH THE HIJACKERS (ICRC POINTS OUT THAT IN THIS CASE THE ALGERIAN GOVERNMENT IS IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH THE HIJACKERS); AND,

--PLEDGES FROM ALL PARTIES THAT THEIR WILL BE NO VIOLENCE DURING THE TIME THE ICRC IS ATTEMPTING TO RESOLVE SITUATION.

ONCE THESE CONDITIONS ARE MET THEN A DECISION TO FORMALLY INTERVENE REQUIRES APPROVAL OF THE ICRC EXECUTIVE COUNCIL. ACCORDING TO ICRC REPRESENTATIVES THESE PROCEDURES HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED OVER THE PAST 15 YEARS AS A RESULT OF LONG AND OFTEN BITTER EXPERIENCE WITH HIJACKINGS.

- 5. AT THE BEGINNING OF OUR CONTACT WITH ICRC ON THIS INCIDENT, MISSION ASKED THAT ICRC INTERVENE, MAKE ITS INTERVENTION PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE AND INTERCEDE WITH THE ISRAELIS TO OBTAIN THE RELEASE OF TWO PRISONERS AS DEMANDED BY THE HIJACKERS. ALTHOUGH ICRC HAS NOT TAKEN FORMAL ACTION, IT NOW APPEARS THAT OUR FIRST TWO REQUESTS HAVE BEEN MET. AS FOR THE THIRD, ICRC HAS TOLD THEY HAVE NO INTENTION OF CONTACTING THE ISRAELIS SINCE THE US IS IN CONTACT WITH THE GOI. AT THE SAME TIME, WE UNDERSTAND THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT HAS TOLD US THAT IT HAS NO INTENTION OF CONTACTING THE ICRC. THIS ISSUE NOW APPEARS AT AN IMPASSE. MISSION INFORMED ICRC OF INFORMATION CONTAINED REFTEL.
- 6. IN REACTING TO THIS SITUATION, ICRC HAS BEEN HAMPERED BY ITS LACK OF OFFICIAL REPRESENTATION IN ALGIERS AND THE

STATE OF ITS RELATIONS WITH SHI'ITE GROUPS WHICH ICRC REPRESENTATIVES DESCRIBE AS "TERRIBLE". ICRC WAS ALSO HANDICAPPED BY LACK OF EMERGENCY PRESS AND PUBLIC RELATIONS FACILITIES. IT WAS THUS NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC STATEMENTS TO BE ORIGINATED IN WASHINGTON, AFTER CONSULTATIONS WITH THE ICRC IN GENEVA.
