2. IN JUNE 19 DISCUSSIONS IN DEFARTMENT, THE ICRC EXPRESSED RESERVATIONS ABOUT ITS TRYING TO INTERVENE WITH BERRI TO SEE THE PRISONERS AND CHECK ON THEIR WELFARE. THOMAS M. ASHWOOD, FIRST VICE PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN AIRLINE PILOTS' ASSOCIATION, TELEPHONED M/CTP OAKLEY JUNE 18 AND SAID HIS ORGANIZATION, TELEPHONES MACED AND SAID HIS ORGANIZATION HAD ASKED HIM TO GO TO ISRAEL TO TRY TO BE HELPFUL IN SOME WAY IN THE RELEASE OF THE TWA HIJACKING HOSTAGES. HE SAID HE PLANNED TO CONTACT THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT AND ALSO THE ISRAELI PILOTS' ASSOCIATION AND ASKED OAKLEY IF THE USG COULD FACILITATE HIS VISIT. OAKLEY SUGGESTED THAT ASHWOOD COORDINATE HIS VISIT THROUGH THE ISRAELI PILOTS' ASSOCIATION AND THAT WE DID NOT THINK A USG ROLE WAS NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE. OAKLEY TOLD ASHWOOD THAT, CONSISTENT WITH OUR OVERALL POLICY ON TERRORISM, THE USG POLICY TOWARD THIS HIJACKING WAS TO MAKE NO CONCESSIONS TO THE TERRORISTS NOR TO REQUEST ISRAEL TO DO SO. HE SUGGESTED THAT THE AMERICAN PILOTS' ASSOCIATION COULD BE HELPFUL BY DISCUSSING WITH ITS ISRAELI COUNTERPARTS WAYS THAT PILOTS ASSOCIATIONS COULD PUT PRESSURE ON BEIRUT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO TAKE STEPS AGAINST HIJACKING.



- 1. CONFIDENTIAL ENTIRE TEXT.
- 2. I DISCUSSED THE BEIRUT HOSTAGE SITUATION WITH THE PRIME MINISTER, SHAIKH KHALIFA BIN SULMAN AL-KHALIFA, YESTERDAY, JUNE 19, AT THE MAJLIS CELEBRATING THE FIRST DAY OF EID AL FITR. THIS WAS PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF REFTEL.
- 3. THE PRIME MINISTER DEPLORED THE HOSTAGE TALKING AND CALLED FOR MAXIMUM COOPERATION AND SHARING OF INFORMATION AMONG COUNTRIES AS THE BEST MEANS TO DETER SUCH INCIDENTS. HE SAID THAT SECURITY WAS BAHRAIN'S MAJOR CONCERN, AND HE SINGLED OUT THE UNITED STATES, GREAT BRITAIN, FRANCE AND INDIA AS COUNTRIES IMPORTANT TO BAHRAIN IN THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION ON TERRORISTS.
- 4. SHAIKH KHALIFA THEN TOLD ME THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF BAHRAIN ALREADY WAS TAKING TOUGH ACTION AT THE BAHRAIN AIRPORT AS PART OF AN ANTI-TERRORIST CLAMPDOWN. 

1. CONFIDENTIAL - ENTIRE TEXT.

THE SITUATION IN BEIRUT REMAINED UNCHANGED OVERNIGHT. BEIRUT VOICE OF THE HOMELAND IN ARABIC STATED THAT ONE OF THE HIJACKERS OPENED FIRE IN THE DIRECTION OF REPORTERS AT THE AIRPORT THIS MORNING. 1. (S - ENTIRE TEXT).

- 2. RABIN'S PRESS SPOKESMAN TOLD US JUNE 20 THAT RABIN REMARKS ON NIGHTLINE CONCERNING THE HOSTAGE CRISIS WERE SPONTANEOUS, NOT PREVIOUSLY COORDINATED WITHIN GOI AND RESULTED FROM WHAT RABIN SEES AS AN ORCHESTRATED CAMPAIGN IN THE AMERICAN PRESS TO PRESSURE ISRAEL FOR RELEASE THE ATLIT DETAINEES.
- 3. SHAI SAID THAT RABIN HAD THE IMPRESSION -REINFORCED BY INFORMATION FROM THE ISRAELI EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON - THAT THERE WAS A GROWING CLIMATE OF OPINION IN THE U.S. WHICH HELD THE ISRAELIS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE HOSTAGE CRISIS AND SAW ISRAELI UNWILLINGNESS TO RELEASE THE ATLIT PRISONERS UNDER PRESSURE AS UNJUSTIFIED. THE QUESTION TO WHICH HE RESPONDED ON NIGHTLINE HAD CRYSTALIZED THOSE SUSPICIONS AND VOKED THE OUTSPOKEN RABIN RESPONSE.
- SHAI ADDED THAT RABIN HAD NO QUARREL WITH THE PRESIDENT'S NEWS CONFERENCE STATEMENTS ON THE CRISIS. HE HAD BEEN REACTING TO A CLIMATE OF PRESS AND PUBLIC OPINION, RATHER THAN TO OFFICIAL STATEMENTS.

SHAI WAS MORE FORTHCOMING THAN HE HAD BEEN IN A PREVIOUS CONVERSATION (REFTEL) IN SAYING THAT IF RABIN WERE TO RECEIVE A SPECIFIC REQUEST FROM THE U.S. HE WOULD RECOMMEND TO THE CABINET THAT THE DETAINEES BE RELEASED. IN THE PRESENT ATMOSPHERE, THE DEBATE ON THE ISSUE IN CABINET "WOULD NOT BE EASY". THE CABINET WAS INCREASINGLY "HAWKISH". SHAI SAID HE HAD SPOKEN THE PREVIOUS DAY WITH LIKUD INNER CABINET MEMBER ARENS, WHO HAD ARGUED THAT EVEN IF THE US MADE A SPECIFIC REQUEST, ISRAEL SHOULD REFUSE TO RELEASE THE DETAINEES.
