HONDURAS-CONTRAS

TEGUCIGALPA: HONDURAS (AP) -- NICARAGUAN REBEL LEADERS SAID THURSDAY THEY WERE JUBILANT AND RELIEVED OVER THE U.S. HOUSE VOTE TO GIVE NON-LETHAL AID TO GROUPS FIGHTING THE LEFTIST SANDINISTA GOVERNMENT IN THEIR COUNTRY.

ROGER HERMANN, POLITICAL COORDINATOR OF THE INDIAN REBEL FORCE WISURA, CALLED WEDNESDAY'S VOTE ''FANTASTIC.''

''OUR SOLDIERS NEED HAMMOCKS, CLOTHES, RAIN PONCHOS AND MEDICINE.
IT'S VERY HARD FOR US TO GET THESE THINGS,'' HE SAID FROM HIS BASE IN HONDURAS.

HE ADDED THAT MISURA SEIZES MANY MEAPONS FROM AMBUSHED NICARAGUAN SOLDIERS, BUT ''ME CAPTURE VERY LITTLE MEDICINE.'' MISURA CLAIMS TO HAVE 5,000 FIGHTERS OPERATING ON NICARAGUA'S ATLANTIC COAST.

THE LEGISLATORS' ''DISPLAY OF CONFIDENCE'' IN THE REBEL CAUSE MAY PROMPT SOME LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES TO SEND THE GUERRILLAS MILITARY RID, HERMANN SAID. HE DECLINED TO NAME THE COUNTRIES.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE HONDURAS-BASED NICARAGUAN DEMOCRATIC FORCE SAID THE HOUSE HAD ACTED ''IN A RESPONSIBLE MANNER.''

''WE ARE NOT ASKING FOR MILITARY AID.'' FRANK ARANA SAID. ''BUT IF EVER WE NEED IT. WE HOPE TO GET THE APPROVAL OF CONGRESS. BECAUSE NOW CONGRESS HAS REALIZED WE ARE FIGHTING A JUST STRUGGLE TO BRING PEACE AND DENOCRACY TO OUR COUNTRY AND TO EXPEL FROM CENTRAL AMERICA THE CANCER OF COMMUNISM THAT IS THREATENING ALL THE REGION THROUGH THE SANDINISTA GOVERNMENT.''

THE HOUSE VOTED 248-184 TO GIVE \$27 MILLION IN AID TO THE REBELS; KNOWN AS CONTRAS, LAST WEEK THE SENATE VOTED TO SEND \$38 MILLION IN ASSISTANCE, AND THE TWO VERSIONS MUST BE RECONCILED BEFORE ANY MONEY IS SENT.

IN COSTA RICA; A LEADER OF THE REVOLUTIONARY DEMOCRATIC ALLIANCE; WHICH ALSO IS BATTLING THE SANDINISTAS; SAID HE HOPED THE AID WOULD ALLOW THE REBELS TO HELP CIVILIANS DISPLACED FROM THEIR HOMES BY THE FIGHTING.

"THE HAVE 100,000 DISPLACED PEOPLE IN THE 35,000 SQUARE KILOMETERS (14,000 SQUARE MILES) IN WHICH OUR FORCES MOVE, WHO ARE LIVING IN EXTREMELY DIFFICULT SITUATIONS AS THEY LACK CLOTHES, SHOES, MEDICINES AND FOOD, "I JOSE DAVILA MEMBRENO SAID.

WICARAGUA-REACTION

MANAGUA: NICARAGUA (AP) -- APPROVAL BY THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NON-LETHAL AID TO ANTI-SANDINISTA REBELS ''IS AN ENDORSEMENT SO REAGAN CAN CONTINUE ATTACKING NICARAGUA;'' THE GOVERNMENT RADIO SAID THURSDAY.

A TELEPHONE CALLER TO THE STATION. THE VOICE OF NICARAGUA, URGED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES TO "KEEP WEAPONS IN THEIR OFFICES TO REPEL AGGRESSION."

BARRICADA, THE OFFICIAL SANDINISTA NEWSPAPER, SAID THE HOUSE ''VOTED FOR DEATH.'' IT ECHOED THE COMMENTS OF MIGUEL D'ESCOTO, FOREIGN MINISTER OF THE LEFTIST NICARAGUAN GOVERNMENT, WHO SAID WEDNESDAY THAT THE HOUSE ACTION WAS A ''VOTE IN FAVOR OF DEATH, DESTRUCTION, AND SUFFERING.''

B'ESCOTO TOLD REPORTERS AT THE UNITED NATIONS IN NEW YORK THAT IT INDICATED THE HOUSE WANTS THE UNITED STATES TO BE A COUNTRY ''FAVORING LAWLESSNESS AND THE PRINCIPLE THAT MIGHT MAKES RIGHT.''

THE AID AUTHORIZATION PROPERTLY HINDERS THE POSSIBILITY FOR A PERCEPUL SOLUTION AND ENCOURAGES THOSE WHO ARE INTENT ON A MILITANT SOLUTION." HE SAID.

HOUSE MEMBERS APPROVED \$27 MILLION IN NON-LETHAL AID TO THE REBELS. KNOWN AS CONTRAS. IN A 248-184 VOTE WEDNESDAY. IT WAS A MAJOR VICTORY FOR PRESIDENT REAGAN, WHO CALLS THE NICARAGUAN REBELS FREEDOM FIGHTERS.

THE SENATE ENDORSED A \$38 MILLION AID PACKAGE LAST WEEK. NICARAGUAN GUERRILLA LEADERS THURSDAY PRAISED THE VOTE.

ROGER HERMANN, POLITICAL COORDINATOR OF THE INDIAN REBEL FORCE HISURA, CALLED IT "FANTASTIC."

''OUR SOLDIERS NEED HAMMOCKS, CLOTHES, RAIN PONCHOS AND MEDICINE.

A SPOKESHAW FOR THE HONDURAS-BASED WICARAGUAN DEMOCRATIC FORCE SAID WEDNESDAY THAT U.S. AID SHOULD ALLOW THAT REBEL GROUP TO MAKE A MAJOR MOVE AGAINST THE SANDIWISTAS IN ABOUT THREE MONTHS.

LEADERS OF THE DEMOCRATIC FORCE AND OF THE COSTA RICA-BASED REVOLUTIONARY DEMOCRATIC ALLIANCE SAID WEDNESDAY IN EL SALVADOR THAT THEY WERE JOINING FORCES. THEY MADE THE ANNOUNCEMENT BEFORE THE HOUSE VOIE.

THE MINISTER FOR THE PRESIDENCY OF NICARAGUA; MANUEL ESPINOZA; TOLD THE ASSOCIATED PRESS THE GOVERNMENT WAS PLANNING AN IN-DEPTH OFFICIAL REACTION RECAUSE OF ''THE GRAVITY OF THE SITUATION.''

BEIRUT CONTROL TOWER SAYS THE PILOT REPORTED ON LANDING THAT ONE GUNHAN HAD PULLED THE PIN OFF A GRENADE AND THE OTHERS WERE BEATING PASSENGERS.

T-W-A OFFICIALS IN ROME SAY MOST OF THE 145 (NEW FIGURE)
PASSENGERS AND EIGHT CREW MEMBERS ARE REPORTED TO BE AMERICANS.

EYEWITHESSES HERE SAID THE PLANE WAITED 10 MINUTES NEAR THE JORDANIAN PLANE WRECKAGE AT THE END OF A RUNWAY AND THEN ROLLED TOWARDS A FUELING STATION NEARER THE TERMINAL AND BEGAN REFUELING.

A HIJACKER, WHO APPEARED TO BE LEBANESE, TOLD THE CONTROL TOWER HE WOULD BLOW UP THE PLANE IF IT WAS NOT REFUELED.

IN A RECORDED CONVERSATION BROADCAST BY A LOCAL RADIO: THE MAN SAID IN ARABIC: ""THE ONLY SOLUTION IS TO REFUEL THE PLANE OR WE WILL BLOW IT UP.""

THE MAN SOUNDED HIGHLY AGITATED AND APPEARED TO HAVE A SOUTH LEBANESE ACCENT. HIS THREAT SEEMED TO INDICATE HE WAS NOT ALONE. BUT THE IDENTITY AND NUMBER OF THE HIJACKERS COULD NOT IMMEDIATELY BE CONFIRMED.

CHRISTIAN ""VOICE OF LEBANON" RADIO SAID AN ANONYMOUS CALLER TOLD IT THREE MEN WITH RIFLES AND HAND GRENADES, APPARENTLY SHI"ITE MOSLEMS, WERE RESPONSIBLE.

BUT AIRPORT OFFICIALS SAID THEY BELIEVED A SINGLE LEBANESE MAN WAS INVOLVED.

RADIO MONITORS HERE LISTENING TO CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN THE PLANE AND THE AIRPORT CONTROL TOWER SAID THEY HEARD A HIJACKER THREATEN TO KILL PASSENGERS IF UNAUTHORIZED PEOPLE APPROACHED THE AIRCRAFT.

"*LET NO ONE APPROACH THE PLANE. OTHERWISE, WE SHALL BEGIN TO KILL THE PASSENGERS." THEY QUOTED THE HIJACKER AS SAYING.

HE WAS ASSURED THAT ONLY REFUELING TERMS WOULD APPROACH. THE REASON FOR THE HIJACKING WAS NOT INNEDIATELY KNOWN.

THE JORDANIAN PLANE DESTROYED ON WEDNESDAY WAS SEIZED BY FIVE LEBANESE SHI"ITES TO DRANATIZE PROTESTS AGAINST ARAB LEAGUE CRITICISM OF A BLOODY SHI"ITE SIEGE OF BEIRUT"S PALESTINIAN REFUGEE CAMPS.

ABOUT 600 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KILLED AND 2,500 WOUNDED IN THE BATTLE OF THE CAMPS, AND ANGER HAS RISEN AMONG AMONG LEBANESE SHI"ITES AT LOCAL AND ARAB CRITICISM OF THEIR ACTIONS.

SHORTLY AFTER THE JORDANIAN PLANE WAS BLOWN UP A MAN REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN A PALESTINIAN SEIZED A LEBANESE AIRLINER APPROACHING LARNACA AIRPORT IN CYPRUS BUT LATER GAVE HIMSELF UP.

NO ONE WAS HURT IN EITHER OF THE TWO HIJACKINGS.

THE HIJACKED TWA PLANE WAS BELIEVED TO BE THE FIRST AMERICAN COMMERCIAL AIRLINER TO LAND IN BEIRUT SINCE SOON AFTER THE START OF LEBANON'S CIVIL WAR 10 YEARS AGO.

AMERICAN AIRLINES STOPPED FLIGHTS TO BEIRUT SHORTLY AFTER FIGHTING BEGAN IN 1975.

GREEK POP SINGER DENIS ROUSSOS WAS AMONG THE PLANE'S PASSENGERS ACCORDING TO OFFICIALS OF HIS RECORD COMPANY IN ROME.

THEY SAID ROUSSOS, 40 TODAY, HAD BEEN DUE TO APPEAR TONIGHT AT A POP MUSIC FESTIVAL IN SIENA IN NORTHWEST ITALY.

THE TRANS WORLD AIRWAYS (TWA) BOEING 727, SEIZED ON A FLIGHT FROM ATHEMS TO ROME IN THE THIRD MIDDLE EAST HIJACK THIS WEEK, LEFT AFTER A 90-MINUTE EMERGENCY REFUELING STOP HERE ON WHICH THE HIJACKERS FREED THE WOMEN AND CHILDREN ON BOARD AND ISSUED A STATEMENT TO NEWSMEN.

READ BY A GUNDAN SPEAKING ARABIC WITH A SOUTH LEBANESE ACCENT. IT ATTACKED ARAB STATES, CALLED FOR THE LIBERATION OF JERUSALEM FROM ISRAEL AND MADE FIVE DEMANDS:

- -- THE RELEASE OF ALL LEBANESE SHI"ITE MOSLEM PRISONERS HELD IN ISRAEL AND THEIR RETURN TO THE SOUTHERN CITY OF SIDON.
- -- INTERNATIONAL CONDEMNATION OF ISRAELI_MILITARY ACTIONS IN SOUTH LEBANON.
 - -- SIMILAR CONDEMNATION OF U.S. SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL.
- -- CONDEMNATION OF A MARCH 8 CAR BOMBING IN A SHI*ITE SUBURB OF BEIRUT THAT KILLED ABOUT 80 PEOPLE, FOR WHICH AMERICAN RESPONSIBILITY HAS BEEN ALLEGED IN LEBANON.
- -- AN END TO FIGHTING BETWEEN LEBANESE NOSLEMS. BLOODY BATTLES HAVE RAGED FOR NEARLY FOUR WEEKS BETWEEN SHI"ITES AND PALESTINIANS IN BEIRUT AND THE SHI"ITES ALSO CLASHED THIS WEEK WITH DRUZE MILITIAMEN.

THE PLANE TOOK OFF AT 1:25 P.M. (6:25 A.M. EDT) AFTER LANDING AT ITS THIRD ATTEMPT 90 MINUTES EARLIER. IT HAD TWICE BEEN REFUSED LANDING PERMISSION BY LEBANESE AUTHORITIES WHO ORDERED OBSTACLES TO BE PLACED ON THE RUNWAY.

HOWEVER, TRANSPORT MINISTER WALID JUMBLATT LATER GAVE EMERGENCY LANDING PERMISSION ON CONDITION THE PLANE WOULD REFUEL QUICKLY AND LEAVE.

IT CAME DOWN NOT FAR FROM THE GUTTED WRECKAGE OF A JORDANIAN AIRLINER SEIZED BY SHI"ITE MOSLEM GUNNEN AT BEIRUT AIRPORT ON TUESDAY AND BLOWN UP AND BURNED BY THEM THE FOLLOWING DAY.

IN ATHEMS, GREEK POLICE SOURCES SAID THE PLANE WAS SEIZED WITHIN MINUTES OF TAKE-OFF, WHEN A MAN OF ARAB APPEARANCE APPROACHED THE PLOT AND THREATENED TO BLOW UP THE PLANE.

THE SOURCES SAID 14 PASSENGERS WERE GREEK BUT THEY HAD NO INFORMATION ON NATIONALITIES OF THE OTHERS ON BOARD.

ATHENS AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS SAID THE PLANE WAS CARRYING 145 PASSENGERS AND EIGHT CREW.

TWA IN NEW YORK SAID THE PLANE WAS FLIGHT 847 FROM ATHEMS TO

HE SAID THEY WERE CARRYING THREE AUTOMATIC RIFELES AND FIVE HAND GRENADES.

AN AIRLINER FLEW LOW OVER BEIRUT AT 11:35 A.M. (LOCAL TIME) ON AN APPROACH RUN TOWARDS THE AIRPORT, BUT IT WAS NOT IMMEDIATELY KNOWN IF IT WAS THE HIJACKED PLANE.

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS AT ATHEMS SAID THE PLANE HAD 153 PEOPLE ON BOARD AND WAS SEIZED AT 10:04 A.M. (LOCAL TIME).

THE THE SPOKESHORAN IN NEW YORK TOLD REUTERS THE ATHENS TO ROME FLIGHT NORMALLY CARRIES PASSENGERS CONNECTING IN ROME WITH A BOPING PAT FLIGHT TO BOSTON AND LOS ANGELES.

HUSSEIN WAS THE MARTYRED SON OF ALL: SON-IN-LAW OF MOHAMMED. WHOM SHI"ITES CONSIDER THE PROPHET'S RIGHTFUL HEIR.

AN AIRLINER FLEW LOW OVER BEIRUT AT 11:35 A.M. (LOCAL TIME) ON AN APPROACH RUN TOWARDS THE RIRPORT, BUT IT WAS NOT IMMEDIATELY KNOWN IF IT WAS THE HIJACKED PLANE.

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS AT ATHENS SAID THE PLANE HAD 153 PEOPLE ON BOARD AND WAS SEIZED AT 10:04 A.M. (LOCAL TIME).

TODAY'S INCIDENT WAS THE THIRD MIDDLE EAST HIJACKING WITHIN FOUR DAYS. A JORDANIAN AIRLINER, SEIZED ON TUESDAY, WAS PARTLY BLOWN UP 28 HOURS LATER BY HIJACKERS AT BEIRUT AIRPORT AND A LEBANESE AIRLINER WAS BRIEFLY SEIZED AS IT APPROACHED LARNACA RIRPORT IN CYPRUS ON WEDNESDAY.

SOURCES IN THE CONTROL TOWER AT BEIRUT AIRPORT SAID TWA'S FLIGHT 847 LANDED THERE AT 11:57 A.M. (4:57 A.M. EDT) IN THE THIRD HIJACKING INCIDENT THIS WEEK INVOLVING THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

IN ISRAEL, AN INTERNATIONAL RADIO MONITOR SAID HE OVERHEARD THE PILOT SAYING ONE HIJACKER HAD PULLED THE PIN OK A HAND GRENADE AND WAS THREATENING TO BLOW UP THE AIRCRAFT.

"DO NOT APPROACH THE PLANE:" A CONTROL TOWER OFFICIAL QUOTED ONE OF THE SUSPECTED SHIITE MOSLEM HIJACKERS AS SAYING. "PLEASE ARRANGE FOR FUEL IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE: WE WILL START KILLING THE PASSENGERS."

THE TOWER SOURCES SAID THE PLANE WAS BELIEVED TO BE CARRYING MORE THAN 100 PEOPLE. IT WAS NOT IMMEDIATELY KNOWN WHERE THE SKY PIRATES, ARMED WITH HAND GRENADES AND SUBMACHINE GUNS, WANTED TO GO.

IN A SECOND RADIO TRANSMISSION WITH THE CONTROL TOWER, THE HIJACKERS THREATENCO TO START KILLING THEIR PASSENGERS WITHIN THREE MINUTES. THE DEADLINE PASSED WITH NO IMMEDIATE WORD ON THE FATE OF THE HOSTAGES.

THE CONTROL TOWER SOURCES SAID THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT AT FIRST ORDERED THE AIRPORT CLOSED TO PREVENT THE AIRCRAFT FROM LANDING, BUT APPARENTLY ALLOWED IT TO LAND IN HOPES OF ENDING THE HIJACKING.

AN ANONYMOUS TELEPHONE CALLER TOLD A PRIVATE BEIRUT RADIO STATION THE PLANE BOUND FROM ATHEMS, GREECE, TO ROME WAS HIJACKED BY MEMBERS OF THE "HUSSEIN SUICIDE BRIGADE" -- A PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN BUT SUSPECTED SHIITE MOSLEM GROUP.

THE CALLER TOLD THE RADIO STATION HIS COMPADES WERE ARMED WITH THREE SOUIET-MADE AK-47 SUBMACHINE GUNS AND FIVE HAND GRENADES.

THE FIRST HIJACKING ENDED WEDNESDAY AFTER 30 HOURS WHEN FIVE SHITE MOSLEMS WHO SEIZED A JORDANIAN AIRLINER FREED 67 HOSTAGES AT SEIRUT AIRPORT, BLEW UP THE JET AND THEN FLED INTO SHITE SUBURBS HEAR THE AIRPORT.

THO U.S. HOSTAGES ABOARD THAT AIRLINER -- AKERICAN UNIVERSITY OF BEIRUT ADMINISTRATOR LANDREY SLADE AND HIS SON -- PROMPTLY BOARDED A MIDDLE EAST AIRLINES FLIGHT TO LARNACA, CYPRUS. THAT PLANE WAS HIJACKED FIVE MINNTES AFTER IT TOOK OFF BY A MAN ARMED WITH A HAND

BEIRUT, JUNE 17, REUTER - U.S. NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISER ROBERT MCFARLANE TODAY TELEPHONED LEBANON'S SHI"ITE MOSLEM LEADER NABIH BERRI TO DISCUSS THE FATE OF AMERICANS HELD HOSTAGE HERE ON A HIJACKED PLANE, A SOURCE AT BERRI'S HOME SAID.

IT WAS THE FIRST TIME AN OFFICIAL IN WASHINGTON HAD CONTACTED BERRI SINCE HE BEGAN NEGOTIATING LAST NIGHT ON BEHALF OF THE HIJACKERS WITH THREE WEST EUROPEAN DIPLOMATS AND OFFICIALS OF INTERNATIONAL AGENCIES.

THE SOURCE AT BERRI'S HOME SAID THE TWO MEN DISCUSSED THE HIJACKING AND THE HOSTAGES. HE GAVE NO FURTHER DETAILS BUT APPEARED TO BE PLEASED MCFARLANE HAD CALLED THE SHI"ITE LEADER.

THE HIJACKERS, BELIEVED TO BE SHI"ITE GUNNEN, DEMAND THAT ISRAEL FREE ABOUT 700 LEBANESE PRISONERS AND THAT SPAIN SHOULD FREE TWO MEN HELD IN MADRID, IN RETURN FOR THE RELEASE OF ABOUT 40 HOSTAGES ON THE TWA PLANE.

BERRI, LEADER OF THE SHI"ITE MILITIA AMAL WHICH CONTROLS BEIRUT AIRPORT, SAID YESTERDAY THE HIJACKERS HAD PLEDGED NOT TO HARM THEIR CAPTIVES WHILE NEGOTIATIONS CONTINUE.

BERRI LAST NIGHT APPEALED TO FRENCH, BRITISH AND SPANISH DIPLOMATS TO INTERCEDE WITH ISRAEL TO FREE THE LEBANESE PRISONERS HELD IN ISRAELI JAILS.

THE SOURCE SAID THERE HAD BEEN NO CONTACTS SINCE MIDNIGHT (5 P.M. EDT) AND THE DIPLOMATS HAD NOT REPLIED TO THE APPEAL.

HOWEVER: A FOREIGN MINISTRY SPOKESMAN IN MADRID SAID SPAIN WOULD NOT RELEASE THE TWO MEN IT HOLDS FOR AN ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT ON A LIBYAN DIPLOMAT LAST SEPTEMBER.

BEIRUT AIRPORT: WHERE AMAL FIGHTERS MAINTAINED AN OVERNIGHT MAXIMUM ALERT AGAINST ANY AMERICAN OR ISRAELI COMMANDO STRIKE TO FREE THE HOSTAGES: WAS CALM TODAY.

A FEW AMAL FIGHTERS LOUNGED NEAR THE PLANE; WHICH RAN ITS ENGINES TO MAINTAIN AIR CONDITIONING INSIDE. THE HIJACKERS REQUESTED WATER, NEWSPAPERS, TOILET PAPER AND 120 SANDWICHES AND ASKED FOR CLEANERS TO GO ON BOARD, AIRPORT OFFICIALS SAID.

THE AMAL AIRPORT COMMANDER ALSO WENT ON BOARD AT THE HIJACKERS" REQUEST, BUT NO FURTHER DEMANDS WERE RADIOED TO THE CONTROL TOWER WHERE THREE AMAL FIGHTERS WAITED WITH OFFICIALS.

""EVERYTING SEEMS FROZEN:"" SAID AN OFFICIAL OF THE LACK OF ACTIVITY, AS A HIJACKER IN A WHITE SUN HAT OCCASIONALLY PEERED FROM THE PLANE"S COCKPIT OR STROLLED ON THE TARMAC.

THERE WAS NO INDICATION OF THE FATE OF SEVERAL AMERICAN PASSENGERS WITH ""JEWISH SOUNDING NAMES"" WHO WERE TAKEN FROM THE PLANE UNDER COVER OF DARKNESS SATURDAY.

ULI DERICKSON, A TWA FLIGHT ATTENDANT WHO WAS FREED IN ALGIERS AND RETURNED TO NEW YORK YESTERDAY, SAID THE GUNMEN HAD ORDERED HER TO GATHER PASSPORTS AND POINT OUT THOSE WHO MAY HAVE BEEN JEWISH. SHE SAID SHE TURNED IN ALL OF THE PASSPORTS; THE GUMMEN MADE THE SELECTION AND SIX TO EIGHT PASSENGERS WERE TAKEN FROM THE PLANE.

DERICKSON SAID THAT IN ADDITION TO THE MAN WHO WAS KILLED; ANOTHER AMERICAN, WHO HAD DONE CONSTRUCTION WORK FOR THE U.S. NAVY IN GREECE, HAD BEEN BRUTALLY BEATEN BY THE HIJACKERS AND WAS IN ""VERY BAD SHAPE"" WHEN SHE LEFT THE PLANE.

SHE SAID THE JET'S PILOT WAS SHOWING SIGNS OF FATIGUE AND ITS FLIGHT ENGINEER HAD BEEN BEATEN WITH A GUN.

PRESIDENT REAGAN, WHO INTERRUPTED A WEEKEND RETREAT AND HURRIED BACK TO WASHINGTON FOR TALKS ON THE CRISIS, SAID THE HIJACKERS SHOULD RELEASE THE HOSTAGES OR FACE THE CONSEQUENCES.

"THERE HAVE BEEN INSTANCES IN WHICH HIJACKERS HAVE FOUND THAT ACTION IS TAKEN THAT RESULTED IN THEIR DEATH OR CAPTURE," HE TOLD REPORTERS.
