YOUR PEOPLE HAVE SUFFERED AS A CONSEQUENCE OF CYCLONES ERIC AND NIGEL. PLEASE BE ASSURED THAT THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ARE CONCERNED WITH YOUR PLIGHT AND READY TO EXTEND THE HAND OF FRIENDSHIP AND SUPPORT DURING THE DAYS AHEAD. AS YOU KNOW, THE FIRST EMERGENCY RELIEF SUPPLIES FROM THE UNITED STATES HAVE ARRIVED IN FIJI. WE STAND READY TO BE OF FURTHER HELP AS YOUR RELIEF AND REABILITATION EFFORTS PROGRESS. SINCERELY, RONALD REAGAN.
