SUBJECT: RECUSAL WITH RESPECT TO FINANCIAL INTERESTS AND
REQUEST FOR A LIMITED 18 U.S.C. SECTION 208(b) WAIVER

I have previously submitted a Financial Disclosure Report pursuant to the Ethics in Government Act. In my report, I disclosed that I have an interest in Brock Candy Company and a number of various entitites, including those held in trust for the benefit of my wife and minor children. I understand that these interests are considered to be financial relationships which are subject to the restrictions of 18 U.S.C. Section 208(a).

Accordingly, I will disclose this situation to my associates and make arrangements to be insulated from any official business matters which may arise which might specifically affect or involve Brock Candy Company (and the commodities: sugar, peanuts, corn syrup, cocoa or chocolate) and the other entities. Should such a matter arise, nevertheless, which to my knowledge might specifically affect or involve Brock Candy Company (and the commodities: sugar, peanuts, corn syrup, cocoa or chocolate) or the other entities, I shall abstain from participating in any manner in that matter.

If these matters arise or are expected to arise to the extent that my continuing abstention, because of the financial relationship, impairs my ability to act as U.S. Trade Representative, I shall request the trustee of my qualified blind trust to dispose of the asset requiring such abstention or request a full waiver under 18 U.S.C. Section 208(b); however, at this time, I request a waiver under 18 U.S.C. Section 208(b) only with respect to matters which may indirectly affect or involve those entities other than Brock Candy Company (and the enumerated commodities).

Except for the Brock Candy Company (and the commodities: sugar, peanuts, corn syrup, cocoa or chocolate), I have determined that the interests in the entities disclosed by Mr. Brock are not so substantial as to be deemed likely to affect the integrity of the services which the Government may expect from Mr. Brock as United States Trade Representative.
