I would like to call your attention to an excellent opportunity for this Administration to demonstrate its consideration for the people of the United States Territory of Guam. Pope John Paul II will be visiting Guam on his upcoming trip to the Far East. He will make two stops on U. S. soil: at Guam, February 22 and 23, and at Anchorage for refueling, February 26. We would recommend that if it is at all possible, you designate William Wilson, your newly appointed Special Envoy to the Vatican, to represent you at the welcoming ceremonies in Guam. If for any reason that designation is not feasible, I suggest that you consider appointing a close personal friend as your representative in Guam for the Pope's visit.

Such representation would be an indication of your hospitality to the Pope, and a demonstration of your desire personally to share in an occasion of special importance to the people of Guam. Guam is a strategically important territory in the Western Pacific, providing key Naval and Air Force facilities. In recent years, Guamanians' profoundly patriotic attitudes, however, have been tested by a vocal minority that thinks Washington ignores Guam's significance. Guam's Governor, Paul M. Calvo, is likely to appreciate your sending the Special Envoy —— or if need be, another Presidential designee —— to hold his first meeting with the Pope on Guam, and he is likely to see it as an indication of this Administration's recognition that Guam is an integral part of the United States.

The Pope's arrival in Guam is now set for 6:50 p.m. on February 22. He will say Mass, participate in a parade, and visit public health care facilities, before departing for Tokyo at 12:30 p.m. on February 23. Governor Calvo and Catholic Bishop of Guam Felixberto Flores are coordinating plans for the Pope's reception.

Recommendation:

That you designate your Special Envoy to the Vatican, or in lieu of him a close personal friend, to represent you in welcoming the Pope to the United States territory of Guam.
