SUBJECT: Nuclear Power Plant Sales to Taiwan

AIT Taipei just reported that Taipower President David Chu formally announced this morning that the winners in the bidding for the next two power plants are Combustion Engineering (US) and Parsons (UK). The former won the nuclear steam supply systems; the latter the turbine generators. Chu said Taipower will now enter into negotiations with those companies. If you wish to inform Meese of this, a memo is at Tab I. Don Gregg concurs.

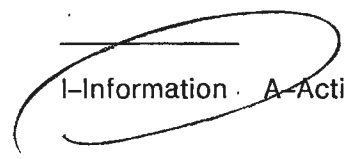

TAIWAN: SPARE PARTS NOTIFICATION

Q: Has the Administration sent to the Congress formal notification of the spare parts sale to Taiwan? How much does it amount to?

A: The Administration sent to Congress today, April 13, formal notification of approval of a \$60 million transaction for the sale of spare parts to Taiwan. This package is part of long-standing supply arrangements and its inception dates back to last summer. No weapons of any kind are involved.

Q: Why was notification delayed so long?

A: There is no deadline for submission of formal notification. We were in regular contact with concerned members and committees of the Congress on this matter.

Q: Have you informed Beijing and Taiwan?

A: Yes. The American Institute in Taiwan has provided appropriate notification to its counterpart organization, and we have also informed Beijing in an appropriate manner. Also, as I indicated to you April 7, we have had discussions on this general subject with Beijing as long ago as December.

Q: Will the Chinese downgrade relations over this sale? Will they protest or do anything else?

A: I will not engage in speculation about that.

Q: Are you going to make further sales to Taiwan?

A: I have nothing further for you on that today, other than to state that our policy in this area remains unchanged.

Q: When do you expect to be announcing further sales?

A: I have nothing for you on that today, but as I have said, there has been no change in US policy in this area.

Q: What about the F5-E decision? Didn't you decide to sell F5-E's to Taiwan?

A: The statements made on January 11 speak for themselves. I have no further comment.

Q: Can you comment on reports that you have offered to put a ceiling on arms sales to Taiwan and are working on some sort of public document to this effect?

A: I don't want to lead you one way or the other on this; I'm not going to get into our diplomatic discussions with the PRC.

Q: Why is this spare parts package for \$60 million, rather than the \$97 million you informally notified Congress of in December?

A: This \$60 million covers spare parts. It is over \$50 million and therefore requires Congressional notification.

Q: But wasn't this package originally supposed to be for \$97 million?

A: Yes, the additional \$37 million was a routine book-keeping transaction involving Taiwan's pro-rata share for the world-wide costs incurred by the US Air Force in maintaining its inventory. No equipment of any kind was covered by this case. Under new legislation dating from December 30, 1981, it is no longer necessary to provide notification for a transaction of this size.

Q: What happened to this \$37 million case?

A: It has been completed.

Q: How often do you make transactions which do not need to be notified to Congress? Do you anticipate more of these cases in the future?

A: I do not want to get into a discussion of all that we do in this area. My purpose today is to clarify the \$60 million case which we have just sent up to Congress.
