MEMORANDUM FOR ROBERT C. MCFARLANE THE WHITE HOUSE

SUBJECT: TWA HIJACKING

Families Contacted about Going to Beirut

Starting the evening of June 26, one Abu Assan Al Sawaan called from Michigan to some hostage families asking if they were interested in traveling to Beirut to meet with the hostages and assist in trying to arrange their release. The same proposal was made by captors of two of the hostages during the telephone calls by the hostages to friends/relatives last night. We have told all hostage families whether contacted by Al Sawaan or not, that we recommend against such trips. We have told both Al Sawaan directly and other Lebanese Shia leaders preparing to travel to Beirut that we oppose family trips. We have been assured by the other Shia leaders that they will try to stop Al Sawaan from promoting such trips. The attachment to this memorandum lists the families contacted by Al Sawaan or by the hostage captors.

Proposal to Transfer Hostages to a Western Embassy

France, Switzerland and Italy have clarified their positions on Barri's proposal to transfer the hostages to a Western European Embassy in West Beirut provided the Western European country guaranteed they would not be released until the prisoners in Israel were freed. The Swiss government publicly stated that it would accept such a transfer only if no conditions were attached. France, also in a public statement, turned down Barri's offer, saying that "We will not substitute ourselves for the jailers." The Italian MFA informed Embassy Rome that they have instructed their ambassador in Beirut to accept the transfer of the hostages immediately, but only if no conditions are posed.
