SUBJECT: Announcement Ceremony for Labor Secretary

Enclosed are two lists: 1) Directory of U.S. Labor Organizations and Officers; 2) Republican Labor Council. I have checked the names of the individuals who I feel should be invited to the announcement ceremony.

POLITICAL CONSIDERATION: I must caution you, and the powers that be at the White House, about the timing of this announcement. The Administration's, and the Republican Party's, standing with organized labor is at an all time low at this moment. To go ahead with the announcement of a new Labor Secretary this week while the entire AFL-CIO leadership is down at Bal Harbour will be again viewed as a snub toward the American labor movement and will be used against us. Additionally, it will most likely decrease the chances of confirmation for the nominee. I don't believe this is something President Reagan or our Party needs at this time in the wake of the Bork defeat. I strongly urge that the announcement be pushed back to sometime next week when the AFL-CIO leadership is back in town. Many of the labor invitees would not attend this ceremony in any case, but to do it this week will just provide them with more ammunition to publicly blast the President and Republicans as totally insensitive to working Americans.
