



SUBJECT: Japan IG - Status Report

The Japan IG, undertaking the mandate given by the SIG-IEP at its January 4 meeting, has launched the MOSS initiative with Japan. Under Secretary Wallis led a group including Under Secretary Olmer, Under Secretary Amstutz, and myself to meet with our counterparts in Tokyo January 28-29. At that meeting the GOJ agreed to the MOSS approach. Both governments have established Under Secretary/Vice Minister led teams in the agreed sectors. All the teams have met at least once bilaterally except Medical Equipment and Pharmaceuticals, which will have its first meeting March 12.

There are two issues which need the attention of the SIG-IEP. The first concerns the Forest Products Sector Team. At the first meeting of this group on February 25 the two sides failed to agree on the agenda. Consistent with the MOSS approach, the U.S. side insisted that all barriers to forest products markets be on the table for review and action.

The Japanese side agreed that all barriers except tariffs could be considered for action. The U.S. side found it unacceptable for the GOJ to exclude a barrier, especially the barrier of highest priority for the United States. Under Secretary Amstutz urged the GOJ to reconsider its position and said he would report the impasse to his government for review.

The second issue is a problem of presentation, which could arise around April 1. The auto restraints will have ended, providing significantly increased access for Japanese autos in the U.S. market. If our efforts to obtain greater access in Japanese markets are unsuccessful, the Administration may be viewed as having made a major concession on autos without receiving anything in return. The most important initiative in this regard is telecommunications. The GOJ regulations to implement the new telecommunications laws will be published by April 1. We are engaged in continuous and intensive discussions with the GOJ concerning these regulations, but most of our major problems remain unresolved. If on April 1 the U.S. telecommunications firms judge that the ordinances deny them fair access, our efforts on telecommunications will be compared unfavorably with the decision on autos.

Other areas could contribute to the unfavorable review:

NTT Procurement: After three years of sharp increases, the fourth year of the agreement will end March 31, with a leveling off of procurement from U.S. sources.

Tariffs: The April 1 implementation of tariff changes announced in April 1984 will include only minor cuts on a few items of interests to the U.S. Most of our requests were ignored.

Nippon Cargo Airline: If we accept the current GOJ proposal to give the new cargo airline access to the U.S. without any offsetting benefits for U.S. cargo carriers, it will add further to the view that Japan is gaining a lot more than it is giving.

We need to be alert to these dangers as we approach April 1.

#### Congressional Contacts

As agreed earlier, it is important to keep the Congress informed of progress in the MOSS initiative. In his testimony before the House Trade Subcommittee on February 28, Ambassador Brock reported on recent developments in U.S.-Japan trade relations. On March 8, I will testify on the MOSS approach before the Senate Trade Subcommittee.


