Speakes provided RR sked ~~for~~ for Saturday:
RR will copter from camp david to andrews at 3:30 p.m. for a ceremony for the 4 slain marines, whose bodies will be re turning from El Salvador. Ceremony begins at 4 p.m. Open Coverage. RR will speak briefly.

Radio address will not be on terrorism or hostages.

Re: meeting with hostage families.
Present were 14 family members, plus RR , McFarlane, Speakes.

Speakes said that when the 2 female ex-hostages walked in, they hugged the president. There were tears in their eyes.

"The president gave them assurances that we were doing ev erything we could. He told them that our paramount interest is the safety of those being held, and that we were making diplomatic efforts to try and gain their release."

Speakes, by the way, declined to provide direct quotes from RR or the hostages, ~~xxxxx~~. Asked why not, he said the families requested a private meeting.

"The families were very ~~supportive, xxxxxxxxxx~~ supportive of ~~the~~ of the way the president is approaching the matter., " ~~the~~ Speakes said.

Asked if any of the family members proposed or urged a swap of the Americans for the Israeli-held Lebanese, Speakes said, "No."
Asked if any concern was expressed about a lack of Israeli cooperation, Speakes said, "I just ~~don't~~ don't want to get into that. "

RR portion of meeting lasted ~~15~~ "15 to 20 minutes," speakes said, but McFarlane stayed on for another 10 to 15 minutes ~~xxxxx~~.
Questioning of McF. was along ~~same~~ same lines, speakes said.

speakes returned to announce that "jose called." jose napoleon duarte called reagan about fifteen minutes after the flight took off. they spoke for 5 to 8 minutes. speakes said, "duarte called to express his concern and condolences over the americans who were killed in san salvador. President Reagan thanked him ~~for his expression~~ and pledged to work with him in pursuit of the common goals we share." speakes added, "reagan raised with hi the special investigative unit that we trained in El Salvador about a year ago to investigate these types of incidents. It (the unit) has not yet been approved and funded by the Salvadoran Assembly. The President asked Duarte to do everything he could to get the unit into action."

Q: What is your reaction to the announcement that the Israelis plan to release a limited number (30 to 50) of the Ansar detainees they are holding at Atlit?

A: -- This is an action by the Government of Israel. I have no comment for you.

Q: Did you ask the Israelis to release these people.

A: I am not going to comment on our diplomatic exchanges.

This is an Israeli action and I refer you to the GOI for comment.

Q: Do you welcome this release?

A: I have nothing for you on that. This is an Israeli action and I refer you to the GOI for comment.

Q: Does this action change or affect your position on dealing with terrorists?

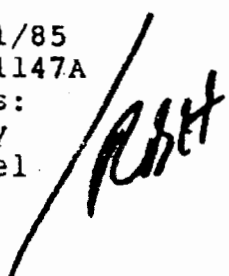
A: Our position remains we will make no concessions to terrorists nor will we encourage others to do so. The TWA hostages are victims of terrorism and must be released without conditions.

Q: Isn't there now a linkage?

A: There can be no linkage between the release of the Ansar detainees and the release of the TWA hostages. The hostages must be released without conditions.

- Please tell me of your concerns.
- I want to assure you that the safety of all hostages and their prompt release is a paramount concern.
- But I also ask you to understand that America's policy not to negotiate with terrorists cannot be compromised, or we will all face an ever-increasing terrorist threat. Our society cannot afford to let terrorism work.
- I would like Robert McFarlane, my National Security Adviser, to provide you with an update on the most recent developments.
- Be assured that we will bring your loved ones home as soon as we can.

do We have such a program now. It was initiated in the early 1970's during the Nixon Administration as a retaliation to the just emerging problem with skyjacking -- in those days mostly flights that were diverted to Cuba. To expand the program would require no legislative action that we are aware of, short of seeking appropriations for outyear spending. We cannot comment on strength of force or methods of operation for reasons of security.

AIR SERVICE TO AND FROM GREECE

Currently, only 3 carriers with direct flights to Athens:

Pan Am
TWA
Olympic (Greek registry)

There are now no more than ten flights daily.

CAN WE TERMINATE SERVICE IF WE DEEM SECURITY TO BE INSUFFICIENT?

Yes. If we think security not up to standards in another country, we can ask that nation to make the necessary improvements. If they do not do so to our satisfaction, we may terminate by their carriers. With regard to U.S. carriers, we may withdraw their authority to operate in any country we choose.

BACKUP NOTES FOR LARRY SPEAKES

FOR BACKGROUNDER ON PRESIDENT'S SPEECH.

Q. WHAT DO YOU HAVE IN MIND IN EXPANDING THE SKY MARSHAL PROGRAM?

A:--WE'VE HAD A PROGRAM SINCE THE LATE 1960'S FOR PUTTING MARSHALS ABOARD SOME FLIGHTS. THE PROGRAM HAS BEEN CUT BACK SOMEWHAT IN RECENT YEARS AS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF AIRPORT SECURITY SCREENING IN THE UNITED STATES HAS IMPROVED AND THE NUMBER OF HIJACKINGS DROPPED OFF, ALTHOUGH MARSHALS ARE STILL USED ON SOME SELECTED FLIGHTS.

WE'LL BE TAKING A LOOK AT WHERE THE MARSHALS MIGHT BE NEEDED THE MOST. THE PROGRAM WILL BE INCREASED IF NECESSARY.

(IT HAD REACHED A PEAK OF 2,000 OR 3,000 MARSHALS. THE FAA DOES NOT WANT TO SAY EXACTLY HOW MANY THEY NOW HAVE.)

Q: HOW WILL WE DECIDE IF THE GREEKS HAVE IMPROVED SECURITY AT ATHENS AIRPORT AND ARE WILLING TO COMPLY WITH THE VARIOUS SECURITY PROVISIONS OF THE AVIATION AGREEMENTS?

A. WE HAVE SENT TEAMS WITH REPRESENTATION FROM THE FAA, IATA, THE AIRLINE PILOTS ASSOCIATION AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT TO ATHENS IN THE PAST TO EXAMINE THE SECURITY SITUATION THERE AND TO OFFER TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN IMPROVING SECURITY PROCEDURES. WE HAVE URGED THE GREEKS TO TIGHTEN THEIR STANDARDS. WE HAVE EXPRESSED OUR CONCERNS TO THEM REPEATEDLY. WE ARE WILLING TO SEND TEAMS OUT AGAIN TO SEE IF THEY HAVE ACTUALLY IMPLEMENTED IMPROVEMENTS.

--THE, TOKYO, MONTREAL AND HAGUE CONVENTIONS ARE INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS ADOPTED OVER THE PAST TWO DECADES WHICH DEAL WITH THE PROSECUTION AND EXTRADITION OF AIRCRAFT HIJACKERS AND SABOTEURS. BASICALLY, STATES WHICH ARE PARTY TO THESE CONVENTIONS (WHICH INCLUDES THE VAST MAJORITY OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY, INCLUDING LEBANON AND GREECE) UNDERTAKE EITHER TO EXTRADITE AIRCRAFT HIJACKERS OR SABOTEURS OR TO SUBMIT THEIR CASES TO THEIR OWN AUTHORITIES FOR PROSECUTION.

Q. UNDER WHAT AUTHORITY CAN WE TERMINATE THE SERVICES OF FOREIGN AIRLINES WHOSE GOVERNMENTS DO NOT HONOR INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS OR PROVIDE ADEQUATE SECURITY AT THEIR AIRPORTS?

A:-- SEVERAL OF OUR BILATERAL AVIATION AGREEMENTS CONTAIN PROVISIONS PERMITTING US TO SUSPEND THE OPERATING RIGHTS OF FOREIGN AIR CARRIERS WHOSE GOVERNMENTS DO NOT LIVE UP TO ADEQUATE SECURITY STANDARDS.

IN ADDITION, IN THE BONN DECLARATION ON AIRCRAFT HIJACKING, ISSUED BY THE LEADERS OF THE SUMMIT SEVEN COUNTRIES (THE U.S., THE U.K., FRANCE, THE F.R.G., JAPAN, ITALY AND CANADA) IN 1978, WE HAVE AGREED THAT WE WILL JOINTLY SUSPEND AIR SERVICES TO AND FROM ANY COUNTRY WHOSE GOVERNMENT DOES NOT LIVE UP TO ITS INTERNATIONAL OBLIGATIONS EITHER TO EXTRADITE HIJACKERS OR SUBMIT THEIR CASES FOR PROSECUTION.

Q. WHAT DO YOU MEAN WHEN THE PRESIDENT SAYS HE CALLS ON OTHER COUNTRIES TO REDOUBLE THEIR EFFORTS TO IMPROVE AIRPORT SECURITY. WHAT KIND OF STEPS ARE YOU TALKING ABOUT?

A:-- WHAT THE EXPERTS HAVE IN MIND ARE SUCH STEPS AS IMPROVING EQUIPMENT SUCH AS METAL DETECTORS, AND PERHAPS EVEN MORE IMPORTANT, THE TRAINING AND DISCIPLINE OF THE SECURITY AGENTS AT THE AIRPORTS. ALSO, SOME AIRPORTS MAY NEED ACTUAL PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE LAYOUT.

Q. WHAT DO YOU MEAN IN SUGGESTING STEPS TO PREVENT TRAVEL TO PLACES WHERE "LAWLESSNESS IS RAMPANT.?"

A. THE MOST OBVIOUS PLACE IS BEIRUT RIGHT NOW. WE HOPE THERE WILL NOT BE OTHERS IN THE FUTURE. TEHRAN IS ANOTHER COUNTRY WHOSE ACTIONS IN THE CIVIL AVIATION FIELD HAVE BEEN LAWLESS. IT HAS REFUSED TO APPLY THE HAGUE, MONTREAL AND TOKYO CONVENTIONS AND IS HARBORING THE HIJACKERS WHO KILLED 2 U.S. OFFICIALS DURING THE HIJACKING OF THE KUWAITI AIRLINER LAST DECEMBER.
