SITREP

Since yesterday Nabih Berri has put forth a new demand, that U.S. naval ships pull back from the waters off the Lebanese Coast.

Meanwhile, CBS and other U.S. networks have obtained and aired a videotape interview with eight of the hostages - none of whom were from the group initially taken off the hijacked plane.

There are conflicting reports about who has actual physical control of the hostages, but we consider Nabih Berri, Minister of Justice and leader of the Lebanese Shiite community to be responsible for the safety and release of the TWA hostages.

U.S. POLICY

- -- We will not make concessions to terrorists and we will not ask others to do so. Conceding to terrorists is tantamount to giving in to blackmailers.
- -- We will not change our policies in response to terrorists threats or demands. To do so only encourages more terrorism which further endangers innocent persons.

HIJACKER DEMANDS

-- hijackers demand release of Lebanese Shiites detained in Israel, before the TWA hostages are released. We firmly reject this linkage. TWA hostages should be released forthwith without conditions.

We believe the Israeli transfer of Shiite prisoners from Lebanon to Atlit was inconsistent with the Fourth Geneva Convention.

Israel's policy on returning prisoners to Lebanon is a matter of record. Release of 31 prisoners June 24 is in line with that policy. We did not ask the Government of Israel to release them. We have no comment on this action.

DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS

- -- We are in close contact with Nabih Berri and other Lebanese leaders.
- -- We are in close touch with governments in the Arab world, Europe, and ourselves. Many governments and international organizations have already issued statements condemning the hijacking and hostage-taking.

U.S MILITARY OPERATIONS

-- All U.S. Navy vessels operating in the Eastern Mediterranean are in international waters.

SITREP

There were no significant developments overnight. The plane remains on the ground at Beirut International Airport. We believe the three crewmen are on board and that the other 37 TWA hostages are in South Beirut.

There are conflicting reports about who has actual physical control of the hostages. We consider Nabih Berri, Minister of Justice and leader of the Lebanese Shirte community, to be responsible for the safety and release of the TWA hostages.

U.S.POLICY

- -- We will not make concessions to terrorists and we will not ask others to do so. Conceding to terrorists is tantamount to giving in to blackmailers.
- -- We will not change our policies in response to terrorist threats or demands. To do so only encourages more terrorism which further endangers innocent persons.

HIJACKER DEMANDS

DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS

- -- We are in close contact with Nabih Berri and other Lebanese leaders.
- -- Government of Algeria has been active since beginning of hijacking. We are in close touch with Government of Syria. Austrian, Swiss and Swedish Governments and International Committee of the Red Cross have all offered to assist in resolving situation.

-- Many governments in the Arab world, in Europe, the Par East, Atrica and South America as well as the United Nations and Organization of the Islamic Conference have issued or intend to issue statements condemning the hijacking and hostage-taking. Others have made their views known to us privately.

U.S.MILITARY OPERATIONS

- -- All U.S.Navy vessels operating in the Eastern Mediterranean are in international waters.
- -- U.S. is not using TWA hijacking as a pretext for a military build-up in the Middle East.

HOSTAGE PAMILIES

-- State Department officials telephone families of hostages twice a day, giving them news and information.

HIJACKING SITUATION

The President, in the meeting with his advisers yesterday, set in motion the development of a series of measures that could increase the pressures on those holding our citizens and those who support the terrorists. Those measures have been developed, and will be reviewed by the President today, with the expectation that some decisions will be made. We do reserve to ourselves decisions on matters to bring preater pressure to bear on the situation.

Does this mean possibly cutting off goods and services to Beirut and the use of the airport?

Yes. ONR option among many. Be prepared to take whatever actions are necessary.

S letter to the President?

Not reconsarily minitary.

Peres letter to the President?

We don't as a rule comment on diplomatic exchanges, but we are in close touch with the Israeli government.

Israeli's planning to release more prisoners on a regular basis?

Don't know. Their decision.

Assad role?

We are in close contact with the Government of Syria. Assad has expressed a wish to be helpful and is in a position to be helpful, but we have seen no apparent moves on the part of the Syrians -- no tangible evidence -- that they are actually being helpful.

Reaction to latest hostage tapes?

A reprehensible attempt to play on the anguish of those families whose loved ones were not shown. The television portrayal provides no basis for satisfaction about the condition of the people who were shown. They were obviously under stress. We consider this an attempt to evade the issue, which is the fundamental barbarism of holding innocent people against their will.

Hostages moved to Bekaa Valley?

We believe the three crewmen are on board the plane at Beirut International Airport and that the other 37 are in South Beirut.

The Department of Defense has identified the victim of the terrorist hijacking of TWA Flight 847. The dead man has been identified as Steelworker Second-Class (Diver) Robert Dean Stethem, USN, of Waldorf, Maryland. The body has been positively identified, using information from service and medical records, by officials at the United States Air Porce Base, Torrejon, Spain. SW2 Stethem was attached to Navy Underwater Construction Team One in Norfolk, Virginia. Next-of-kin have been notified. No further information is available at present.
