Scheduling Request

Upon a suggestion from Senator Robert Dole, Chairman of the Finance Committee, it would be very useful to the President in getting his debt limit bill passed if the First Lady would schedule a luncheon in the White House with the wives of Senators Long, Packwood, Roth, Danforth, Harry Byrd, Bentsen and Matsunaga. If appropriate we would recommend that Senator Dole's wife be invited also.

The timing of the lunch is critical. The debt limit will be coming up in committee Wednesday, February 4, 1981 and the lunch should be scheduled prior to that time. If the lunch can be scheduled, let me know and we will prepare a short briefing paper for the First Lady.
