Dear Mr. President:

The North Carolina Republican Party has decided to hold an annual Ronald Reagan Dinner in our state. The dinner will be held each year and will continue after your Presidency concludes in eight years.

The chairman of the first dinner is State Senator Cass Ballenger, who, as you recall, served as the Co-Chairman of your campaign in our state. State party chairman Dave Flaherty, Cass, and others join me and the North Carolina Congressional Delegation in inviting you to address the first annual dinner late this summer or early fall in our state.
