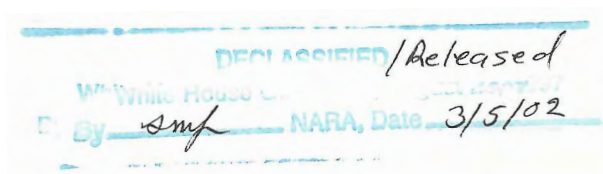

Dear Mr. Pendergast

I have been asked to pass the following message to you from the Prime Minister of Australia, the Honourable Robert Hawke.

"Dear Ron,

Please accept my warmest congratulations on your success in the elections.

When we met in June last year, I emphasised the fundamental importance that we in the Australian Government attached to the relationship with the United States and the constructive approach that Australia would take to our alliance.

During your first term of office, the relationship between our countries has been close and productive. Indeed, I am firmly of the view that it has never been better. Although, as thriving democracies and old friends, we will necessarily have differences on some matters, I am confident that our partnership will remain strong during your continued presidency of the United States.

I know from recent correspondence between us of the close personal attention you are giving to the vital issues of peace, arms control and disarmament. I believe that your re-election to a second term provides an historic opportunity for reaching agreement with the Soviet Union, in order to rid the world of the threat of nuclear war.

The central challenge is to get under way an enduring process of balance and verifiable reductions in the US-Soviet nuclear arsenals. It is only too clear from the history of the postwar period that stable and constructive relations between the superpowers cannot be sustained in the atmosphere generated by mutual threats of mass destruction.

Nor can we afford to presume the perpetual efficacy of this deterrent relationship. With confidence in the strength and credibility of the US deterrent posture restored, the imperative now is to look beyond a deterrent relationship based on massive nuclear arsenals.

You have my unequivocal support and best wishes for success in this enterprise, which is fervently desired by the peoples of the world, and certainly by the people of Australia. The Australian Government for its part will do everything in its power to assist.

Among the many common aspirations we share is a concern for, and belief in, the future of the Western Pacific. The Australian Government has been delighted to see the importance which your Administration attaches to the countries of this region. I believe in the great potential of the Asia-Pacific region and intend to maintain and develop further the productive involvement of Australia in it as one of the major goals of my Government.

The immediate future is a period of great challenges, and potentially, corresponding rewards. I am confident that, under your leadership, the United States will meet these challenges boldly and creatively. And, building on the friendship we have developed in the last 18 months, I look forward to working closely and constructively with you in the interests of both our peoples.

WORLD REACTION TO REAGAN -- FROM GLOOM TO JOY

LONDON, NOV 7, REUTER - WORLD REACTION TO PRESIDENT REAGAN'S LANDSLIDE REELECTION RANGED FROM GLOOM TO JOY, BUT HIS VICTORY CAME AS NO SURPRISE TO EITHER FRIENDS AND ENEMIES.

HERE ARE BRIEF SUMMARIES FROM WORLD CAPITALS:

MOSCOW - THE SOVIET NEWS AGENCY TASS REPORTED WITHOUT COMMENT THAT DEMOCRATIC CHALLENGER WALTER MONDALE "HAS HAD TO ADMIT HIS DEFEAT" BUT IT AVOIDED REFERENCE TO A REAGAN VICTORY.

MANAGUA - NICARAGUA'S LEFT-WING LEADERS PREDICTED REAGAN'S VICTORY WOULD MEAN FOUR MORE YEARS OF DEATH, DESTRUCTION AND ECONOMIC PRIVATION FOR THEIR COUNTRY.

"WITH REAGAN'S REELECTION, WE ARE ON THE BRINK OF A NORTH AMERICAN INVASION," DANIEL ORTEGA, COORDINATOR OF NICARAGUA'S GOVERNMENT JUNTA, TOLD REUTERS. "IF THERE IS AN INTERVENTION, NORTH AMERICAN SOLDIERS WILL DIE EVERY DAY."

TOKYO - JAPANESE PRIME MINISTER YASUHIRO NAKASONE TOLD REAGAN IN A TELEPHONE CALL THAT HE HAD ACHIEVED A HISTORIC FEAT.

"LET US WORK TOGETHER FOR WORLD PEACE, PROSPERITY AND DISARMAMENT AS WELL AS FOR BETTER RELATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND JAPAN," SAID THE PRIME MINISTER, HIMSELF JUST CONFIRMED IN OFFICE FOR TWO MORE YEARS.

PEKING - CHINA'S OFFICIAL PRESS AGENCY SAID REAGAN'S VICTORY HAD COME AS NO SURPRISE. IN APRIL, CHINA'S LEADERS GAVE HIM A RED CARPET RECEPTION IN PEKING JUST AS HE WAS ABOUT TO DECLARE HIS CANDIDACY FOR A SECOND FOUR-YEAR TERM.

PARIS - LUMINARIES OF FRENCH HIGH SOCIETY CELEBRATED REAGAN'S VICTORY AT THE PARIS OPERA WITH A STRAVINSKY BALLET AND A DIONNE WARWICK CONCERT, FOLLOWED BY LIVE TELEVISION ELECTION COVERAGE.

THE U.S. EMBASSY HOSTED A BREAKFAST WITH FRENCH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND POLITICAL COMMENTATORS.

RIO DE JANEIRO - "IT HAS BEEN DEMONSTRATED HISTORICALLY THAT REPUBLICAN GOVERNMENTS ARE BEST FOR SOUTH AMERICA," SAID PAULO MALUF, THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE FOR BRAZIL'S RULING PARTY IN JANUARY ELECTIONS.

REAGAN'S VICTORY WOULD PROBABLY RESULT IN A CUT IN U.S. INTEREST RATES TO 10 PER CENT WITHIN TWO YEARS, HE SAID.

MEXICO CITY - A MEXICAN FOREIGN MINISTRY OFFICIAL, WHO ASKED NOT TO BE IDENTIFIED, PREDICTED MEXICAN-U.S. TIES WOULD REMAIN "VERY SOLID."

BUT HE INDICATED MEXICO WAS IRRITATED AT REAGAN'S CENTRAL AMERICAN POLICY AND AT U.S. REJECTION OF A PEACE TREATY FOR THE AREA DRAFTED BY THE SO-CALLED CONTADORA GROUP -- MEXICO, PERU, VENEZUELA AND COLOMBIA -- SEEKING PEACE IN THE REGION.

LIMA - PERUVIAN VICE PRESIDENT JAVIER ALVA TOLD REUTERS HE HOPED REAGAN WOULD TAKE A COURSE THAT WOULD BRING THE UNITED STATES CLOSER TO LATIN AMERICA "AND ABOVE ALL CONCERN HIMSELF WITH THE ECONOMIC SITUATION NEARLY ALL CENTRAL AND SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES ARE GOING THROUGH."

SAN SALVADOR - JULIO ADOLFO REY PRENDES, EL SALVADOR'S MINISTER OF THE PRESIDENCY, REACTED TO THE REAGAN VICTORY WITH SATISFACTION. "NORTH AMERICAN AID, NORTH AMERICAN SUPPORT WILL CONTINUE," HE SAID.

EL SALVADOR'S GUERRILLAS SHOWERED REAGAN WITH INVECTIVE. "THE ENTIRE WORLD HAS LIVED THROUGH FOUR YEARS OF TERROR AND ANGUISH WITH THE DEMENTED, BELLICOSE POLICY OF RONALD REAGAN AND HIS AIDES," GUERRILLA RADIO FARABUNDO MARTI SAID.

HAVANA - THE MOOD HERE WAS RESIGNATION. "WE'VE KNOWN FOR THE LAST SIX MONTHS OR SO THAT ONLY A MIRACLE COULD PREVENT REAGAN GETTING ANOTHER FOUR YEARS IN THE WHITE HOUSE. SO IT IS NO BIG NEWS," ONE MID-LEVEL COMMUNIST PARTY OFFICIAL SAID IN HAVANA WITH A SHRUG.

SEOUL - THE SOUTH KOREAN GOVERNMENT SAID IN A STATEMENT IT WARMLY WELCOMED REAGAN'S VICTORY WHICH "BESPEAKS THE AMERICAN PEOPLE'S WHOLEHEARTED TRUST IN HIS DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS AND UNTIRING ENDEAVORS TO BUILD A MORE PEACEFUL AND SAFER WORLD."

SYDNEY - AUSTRALIAN PRIME MINISTER BOB HAWKE SAID THE VICTORY PROVIDED A CHANCE FOR THE UNITED STATES TO REACH AGREEMENT WITH THE SOVIET UNION ON ENDING THE THREAT OF NUCLEAR WAR.

TAIPEI - TAIWAN SAID IT HOPED ITS TIES WITH WASHINGTON COULD IMPROVE DURING REAGAN'S SECOND TERM.

ISLAMABAD - PAKISTANI PRESIDENT MOHAMMAD ZIA-UL-HAQ HAILED REAGAN'S RE-ELECTION AS A GLOWING TRIBUTE TO WHAT HE CALLED THE PRESIDENT'S INSPIRING LEADERSHIP.

SINGAPORE - GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND BUSINESS LEADERS SAID THE VICTORY AUGURED WELL FOR NON-COMMUNIST SOUTHEAST ASIAN COUNTRIES WITH CLOSE ECONOMIC AND SECURITY LINKS WITH THE UNITED STATES.

MANILA - PHILIPPINE PRESIDENT FERDINAND MARCOS SAID REAGAN'S RE-ELECTION WOULD REDUCE THE RISK OF THERMONUCLEAR WAR AND ALSO HELP THE PHILIPPINES ECONOMIC RECOVERY.

"RE-ELECTION OF THE AMERICAN PRESIDENT NOW GIVES ALL HOPE THAT THINKING MEN ULTIMATELY WILL BE ABLE TO RE-ESTABLISH SANITY IN THE WORLD AND THAT THE BALKANISATION OF SMALL COUNTRIES, LIKE OURSELVES, WHO CANNOT DEFEND THEMSELVES WILL STOP," MARCOS SAID.

AMMAN - JORDAN HOPES RONALD REAGAN'S VICTORY WILL REVIVE AND ACCELERATE THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS, FOREIGN MINISTER TAHER AL-MASRI SAID.

"REAGAN'S CRUSHING VICTORY WILL STRENGTHEN HIS POSITION AND FREEDOM TO TAKE DECISIONS VIS-A-VIS PRESSURE GROUPS WHICH TRY TO DEFLECT AMERICAN POLICY AWAY FROM A JUST AND PERMANENT PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST," HE SAID.

HE ALSO URGED A UNIFIED ARAB STAND TOWARDS THE NEW AMERICAN ADMINISTRATION AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATION.

JERUSALEM - ISRAELI OFFICIALS SAID TODAY THEY ANTICIPATED GREATER U.S. INVOLVEMENT IN EFFORTS TO ARRANGE AN ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL FROM LEBANON.

PRIME MINISTER SHIMON PERES SENT A TELEGRAM OF CONGRATULATIONS EXPRESSING HIS CONFIDENCE THAT "CLOSE AND FRUITFUL COOPERATION BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES WILL CONTINUE."

BONN - WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT KOHL, SPEAKING ON MORNING TELEVISION, SAID THE ELECTION WAS "VERY MUCH A PERSONAL SUCCESS FOR RONALD REAGAN."

KOHL SAID REAGAN WAS A MUCH MISUNDERSTOOD IN EUROPE.

"I KNOW HIM VERY WELL, WE HAVE FRIENDLY RELATIONS, AND THE UPRIGHTNESS OF HIS CHARACTER, HIS POWER OF PERSUASION HAVE CERTAINLY HELPED HIM WIN THIS VICTORY."
