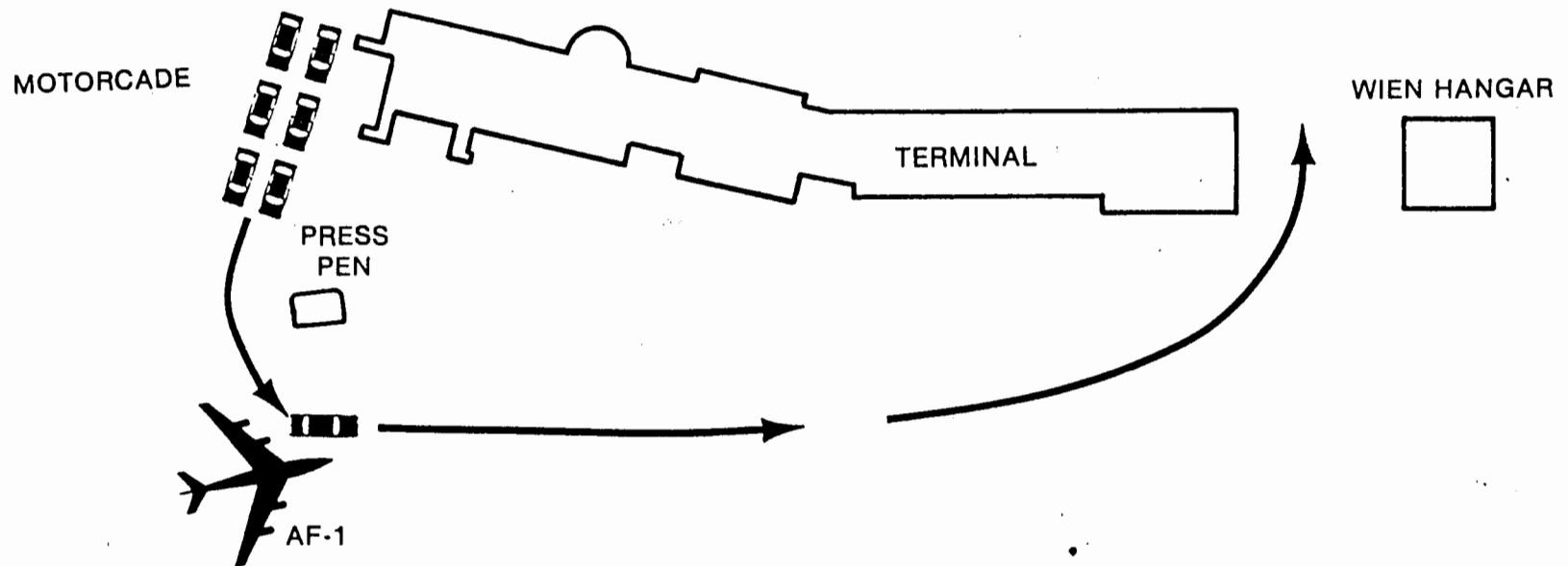

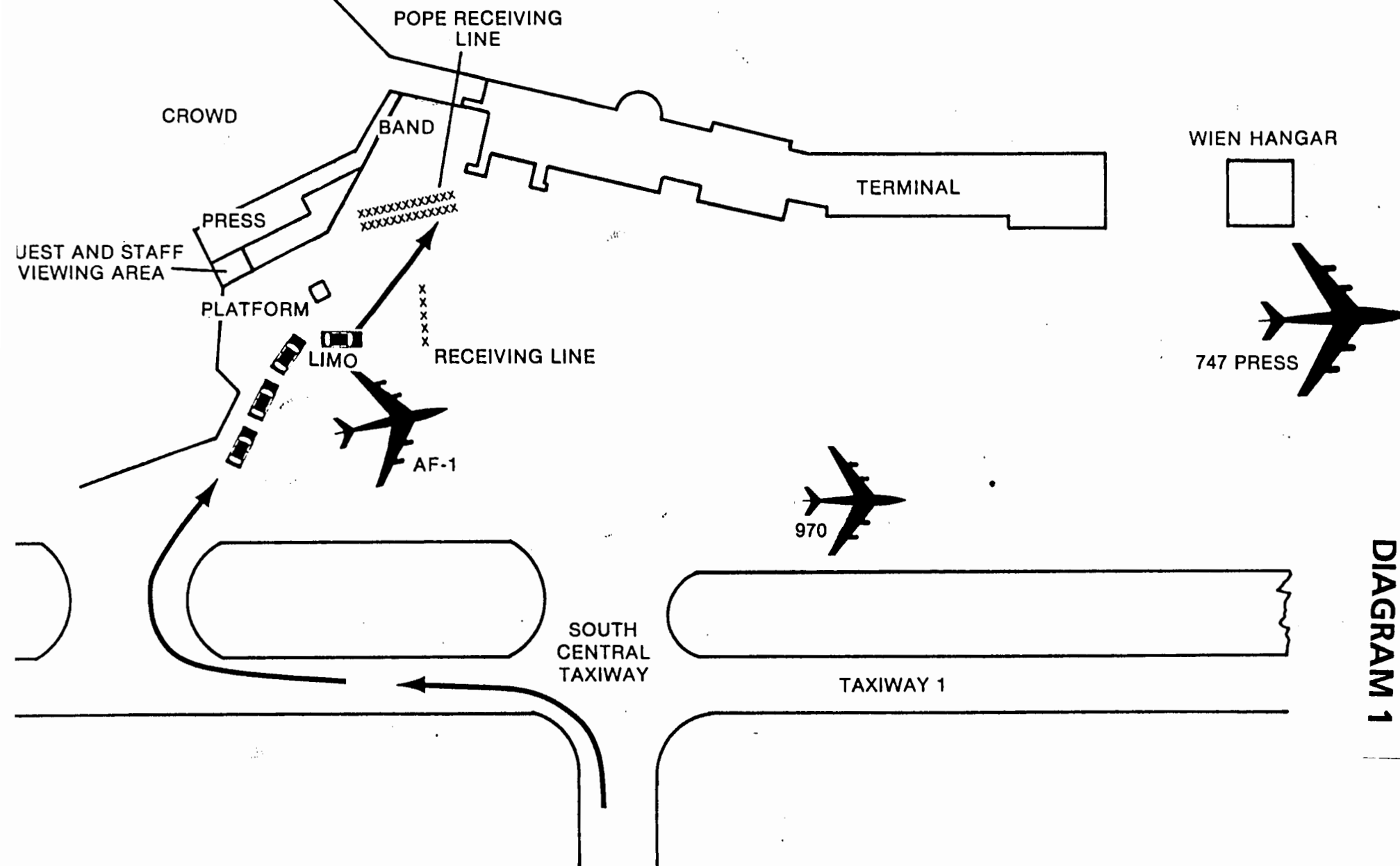

# FAIRBANKS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FAIRBANKS, ALASKA POPE'S ARRIVAL

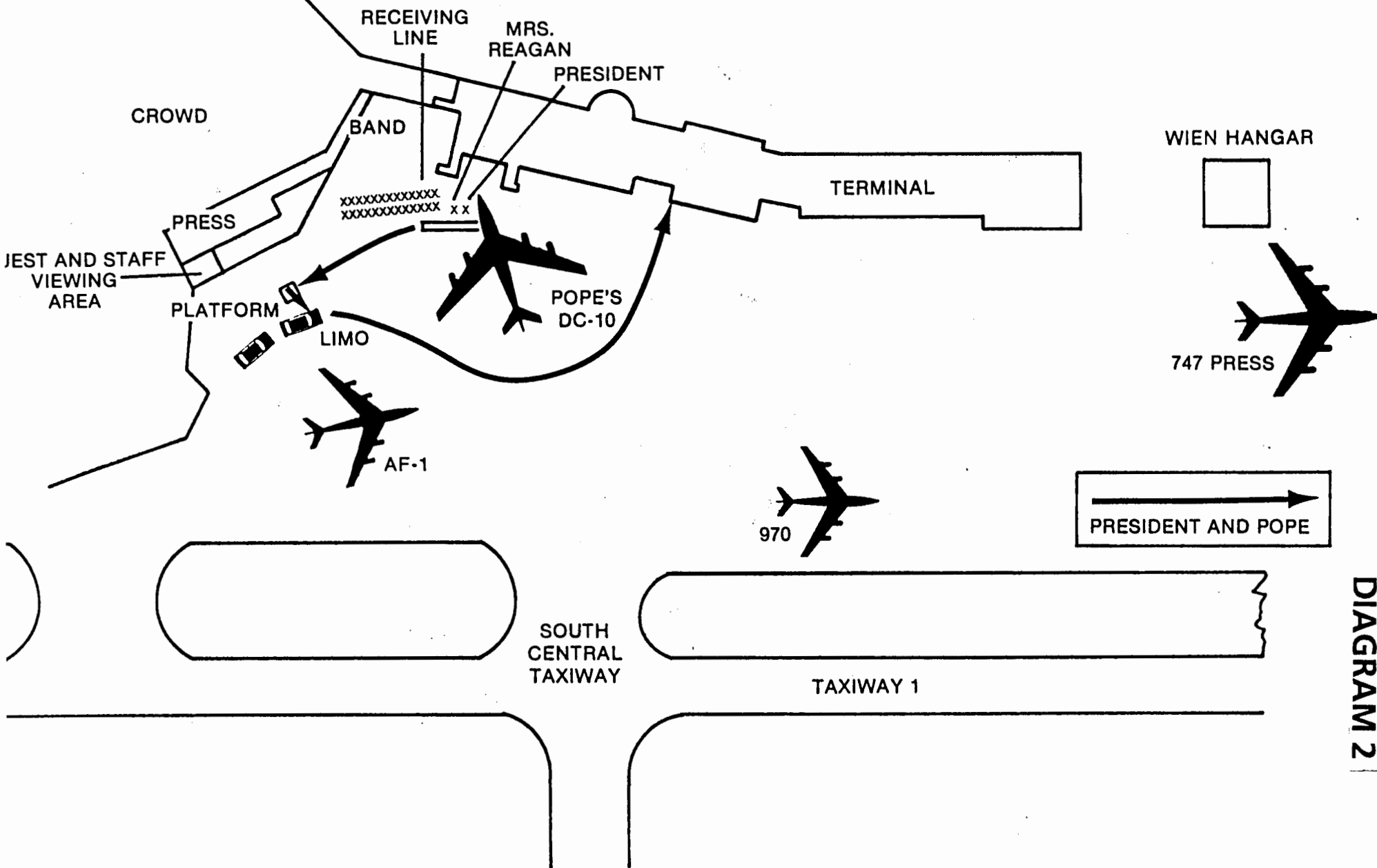

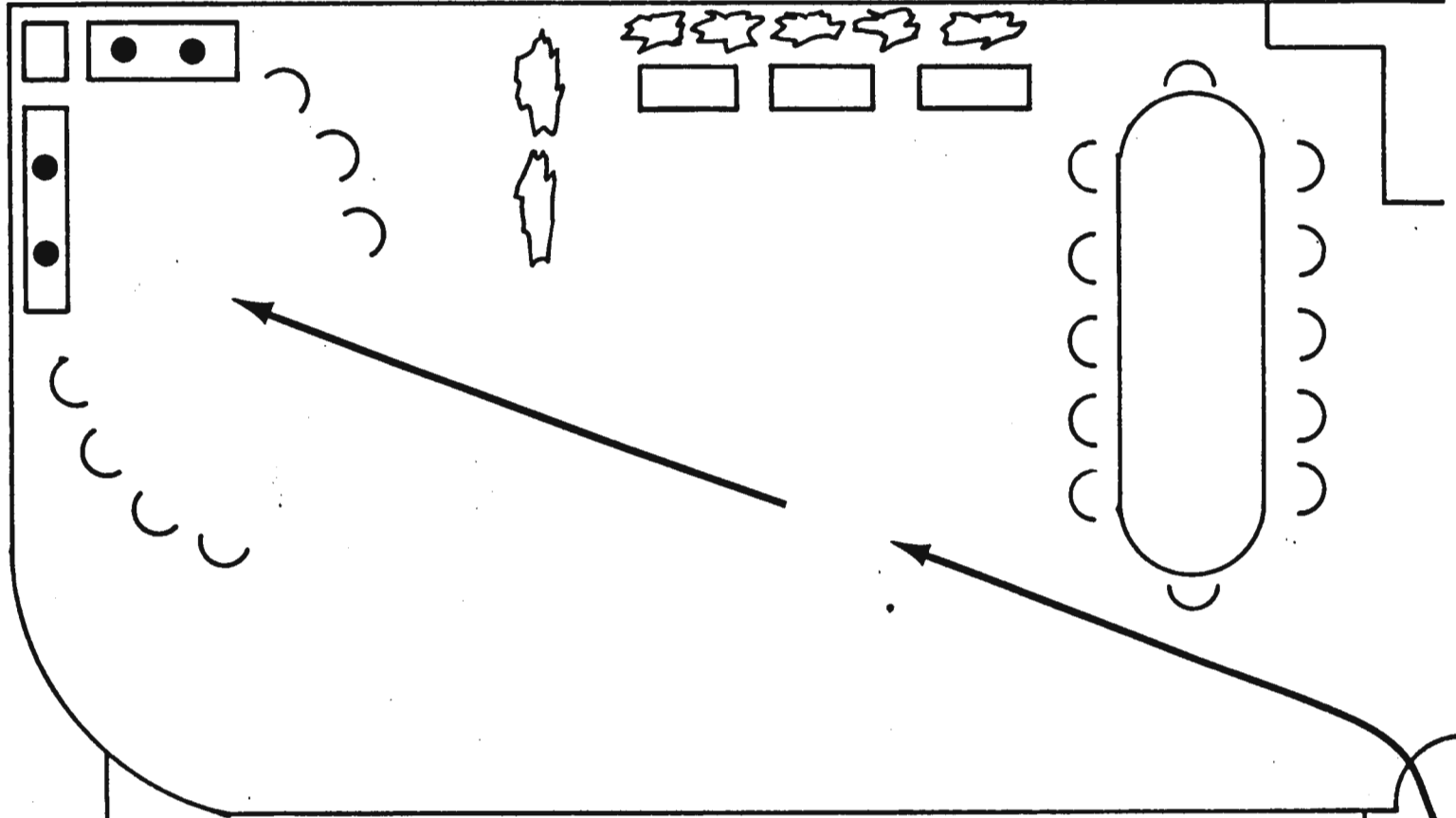
