TALKING POINTS FOR THE PRESIDENT'S LUNCHEON WITH THE CARDINALS AND ARCHBISHOPS

- The following subjects are most likely to be raised by the members of the Catholic hierarchy attending the luncheon.

 They will wish to discuss the topics which they have asked to be briefed on following the luncheon. These topics are:
 - (1) Family issues: respect for the sanctity and dignity of human life (abortion), pornography and tuition tax credits
 - (2) Central America
 - (3) Arms control
- -- The speakers at this two hour briefing which will be held in the Old Executive Office Building are:
 - o Ken Dam on Central America
 - o Secretary Terrel Bell on tuition tax credits
 - o Dr. C. Everett Koop on pro-life issues
 - O Commissioner of Customs William von Raab and
 Stephen Galebach, Executive Secretary, White House
 Working Group on Pornography on pornography
 - o Ambassador Ed Rowny and Sven Kraemer, NSC, on arms control
- -- Other subjects the Bishops may raise are the kind of population planning in our AID programs and the safety of Christians in Lebanon.
- -- Subjects which would favorably capture their attention if raised by us at the luncheon include:

- o Income tax policy as it affects the family, i.e., the erosion through inflation of the dependent exemption and the President's request to the Treasury Department to recommend ways to make taxation more fair for families.
- o Parental notification Title X. Parental authority has been undermined by the disbursal of birth control materials to minors without parental notification. This is irresponsible and a violation of parental rights. Title X, the family planning program, is up for reauthorization this year. We ought to see that a requirement of parental notification becomes part of the reauthorization.
- -- I want to thank especially Cardinal Krol for his eloquent statement he issued in support of school prayer. I also want to thank him for Monsignor John Foley's excellent efforts in debating on television on behalf of the school prayer amendment. Obviously the Pope is aware of Monsignor Foley's abilities as he has appointed him to head Vatican Communications.
- -- The equal access concept, moving quickly now in the House and the Senate, will be an excellent way to accommodate student groups for prayer, Bible study, and religious discussion on the same basis as other extracurricular student clubs.
